Many have argued the world is moving towards techno-polarity, where technology shall define the power centres to come. Great powers are taking notice, expanding their technological capabilities and safeguarding innovation. Conflicts in Russo-Ukraine and the Azerbaijan-Armenia war have also highlighted the impact technology has on determining battle field outcomes.

How tech will define National Power?

A) Tech provides advantages on the Battle field

The Nagorno Karabakh war made the role of technology apparent. Azerbaijan gained the upper-hand on the traditionally armed Armenian forces using Turkish made drones to pin point bunkers. The Russo Ukrainian war has highlighted the use of 'Drone Swarm tactics' with Bloomberg reporting Ukrainian plans to establish one of the largest drone factories for this very purpose. These tech-driven tactics were highlighted in Operation Swift Retaliation where jammers were used against Indian aircraft leading Abhinandan to ditch on Pakistani soil.

B) The Power of Dis-information and Narrative Control

The revelation of the Indian dis-info labs laid apparent

the power of technology to influence narratives. fragile democracies and internal strife can be exploited by outside actors to weaken the enemy from within, with culpable deniability.

c) Technology defining Prosperity and Power

AI has the power to revolutionize the way the world engages in work. Goldman Sachs predicted the loss of 250 million jobs by 2030 to AI. This, in a world of globalized trade means a competitive edge, and cheaper production. Nations with superior technology can thus become economic powerhouses.

D) Controlling the flow of Prosperity: New tech Sanction?

The Crowd Strike Outage and its far-reaching affects on global industry from flights to Surgery Made the world's dependence apparent.

Similarly the Ukrainian power network was taken down by hackers making it clear how warfare of the future would not be limited to the battlefield.

h) The power of information on battlefield outcomes

The breaking of the Enigma codes in WW2 was seen as a potent factor in overall success. Similarly, the ability to use satellites, and break into communication channels provide a significant advantage in pre-empting enemy action.
