Apartheid refers to the implementation and maintenance of a system of legalized racial segregation in which one racial group is deprived of political and civil rights. Apartheid is a crime against humanity punishable under the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court.

>>>> The term "apartheid", an Afrikaans word, derived from the French term "mettre à part", literally translated to "separating, setting apart."

>>> Apartheid is a policy that is founded on the idea of separating people based on racial or ethnic criteria. Usually, the separation operated by apartheid is exercised over geographical areas, putting one part of the population in an area separated from the others, or forbidding a group to access some areas solely based on their belonging to a race or ethnicity, restriction of movement, prohibiting access to certain public spaces.

>>>> Thesis

Israel's systematic domination and oppression of Palestinians, characterized by inhuman acts, demographic changes, expropriation of the property Land, unlawful killings, settlement expansion, displacement, segregation laws, home demolitions, torture, movement restrictions, and forcible transfers, constitutes an institutionalized regime. This regime favors one ethnic group at the detriment of another, amounting to apartheid.
