Education through open university has become an increasingly significant mode of learning in the 21st century. Most of developing countries are using this medium for an progressive approach to education. While Pakistan is one of them. However, there are many strengths and weakness of education through open University. The most commonly strengths includes: an affordable education, accessibility and immediate feedback while the weakness are, lack of ^{face-to-face} interaction, Technical problems and administration and faculty. So serious and honest efforts are needed to solve the issues of education through the open university. Therefore, the main aim of the essay is to discuss the strength and their weakness of education through distance.

First come with the strength of education through the open university in which affordability stands prominent. Most of the institutions uses digital material in online learning as to create a rich, interactive learning environment. Digital textbook and online resources can be easily

used by those students who cannot afford it either books or printing costs. for example there are number of websites or apps which can be used for online educational material such as google classroom, duolingo, edx etc. moreover, education through open university reduces or saves travel cost. students can take classes from their own homes which saves on transportation expenses such as fuel, public transit fares, parking fees and vehicle maintenances cost. so this education from home not only saves travel cost but also saves times which can be redirected towards studying, work, personal activities, family responsibilities such as child care. open university education allows the married people to manage their time effectively with childcare responsibility, which reduces the need of childcare services. for example, in pakistan, many people do CSS from home along with their responsibilities.

The second strength of education through the open university is accessibility. it means that a broader audience can reach from all corners of the country, regardless of their geographical location. Students from all rural areas can have an access to education through distance learning. for example, in pakistan^{some areas of}, girls are not allowed to go outside for education (because of co-education) in that case online

education has helped them to fulfill their dreams. Moreover, education through open university provides an opportunity for students with physical disabilities. There are several universities all over the world which are offering online education such as "open university" in United Kingdom, which is dedicated to distance learning, while in Pakistan, Allama Iqbal Open University, COMSATS University, University of Peshawar etc. are facilitate students with e-learning. Hence, As the studies found that online education has improved literacy rates in Pakistan, particularly among the youth. About 62.3% has increased (2020) from 58% in 2015 — Pakistan Bureau of Statistics. In addition to, lectures from open/online education can be recorded, which can be used for future references as well. For example, people who do jobs along with studies can easily listen/read carefully later at any time and any place. Also recorded lecture can be especially helpful for students with disabilities, language barriers or those who miss a live lecture. For instance, zoom app can be used for this purpose. So this highlights the strengths of education through the open university.

The third strength of education through the open university is its immediate feedback. Online quizzes and assessments provide immediate feedback, which enables the student to track their progress and to identify

their weak areas. Furthermore, online platform can automatically grade assignments and exams, which saves instructors time and reduces the likelihood of errors, allowing them to concentrate on providing constructive feedback that guides student's learning. Gamification or game based learning can be used for immediate feedback which increases engagement of students and motivates to continue learning. There are several platforms which can be used for immediate feedback such as learning management system (LMS), Duolingo, Google classroom etc.

On the other side, there are several weaknesses of education through open university along with strengths. The first weakness of education through the open university is lack of physical presence. Students cannot have face-to-face interaction which leads to the lack of social interaction and connection of traditional classroom learning that may results in isolation and disconnection. Students feel isolated from others and may miss out the opportunity to build relationships with peers and instructors. For example, some subjects, such as lab sciences or performing arts, may be difficult to learn in an online environment. While students of literature, Biology, Chemistry etc. may not

do not have access to libraries or laboratories. Moreover, without face-to-face interactions, students may feel more anonymous and less inclined to participate actively in online discussion. Also, student may find it easier to disengage in online education without feeling guilty or accountable.

The second main weakness of education through the Open University is Technical Issues. Technical problems can interrupt the learning process, causing a disengagement among students, decrease in motivation. It can also lead to missed deadlines, lost work, and decreased academic performance. Moreover, inadequate internet connectivity can hinder online education.

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The third weakness of education through open university is Administration and faculty. The absence of well-defined policies and procedure can lead to confusion and inconsistencies in online education. Without proper training, faculty may struggle to navigate the online learning environment, resulting in disorganization and inefficiencies. So we can say that failure to provide faculty with necessary training and support for online teaching can lead to poor course quality. But sometimes, some faculty members feel uncomfortable with technology, an

leading to resistant to change. They may be concerned that e-learning will compromise quality or it may require more time for preparation. In addition to these problems, sometimes the Administration and faculty focuses on revenue over quality by prioritizing enrollment numbers over student success, focusing on superficial engagement over meaningful learning, by ignoring student feedback and concerns etc. So all of these reasons makes education weak in open universities.

But those weakness can be overcome by making clear policies, faculty training programs, student feedback and evaluation.

Conclusion: As to conclude, there are several strengths and weaknesses of education through the open university such as affordability, accessibility, immediate feedback, lack of physical presence, technical issue. To fully leverage the potential of online education, some serious and honest efforts are needed.
