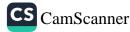

Hnswer Introduction The term ideology is a complex phenomenon in study of social sciences on which a great deal of cont-roversy exists among scholors on its meaning and depinition. The French philosopher Hutoine Destull de Tracy used the word ideologie during French Revolution and define it as the science of ideas meaning thereby the <u>science</u> of ideas meaning thereby as the study of <u>origins</u>, evolution and nature of ideas. The ideologies Contain a set of proposals about human nature and society. These proposals explicitly (in clear and detailed manner) manifest human condition, approaches and understanding of a social and political order and provide a basis for the accomplishment of a desired social System.

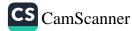

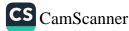
