Per example one example of legal and structural hurdles in inefficiency of 2002 legan reform in Pakistan introduced under President larver Musharaf, siming to increase women's participation in legislative bodie by reserving 17% of seat for women in National and Braincial Assemblies. It was limited its inability la significantly enhanace women's political influence. (d) Socio-Economic challenges: The financial divide. socio-economic challenges severely limit women's political representation in Pakistan, particulally due to economic dependencies. Many women lack the financial resources for political campaigns which are resource intensive for example according to occi report of 2024 ditled "Increasing Momen's Inclusion in the Pakistan Fromony", while women constitute & 49% of population, only 24%

of them are actively involved in economic activity. The FLFP rate remains the lowest among regional peers, with only 211. of eligible Demale workers employed formall this financial divide limits their performance exhibition. Moreover, there are insufficient opportunities for political Iraining and skill development, leaving many women ill-prepared for the complexities of political life-(e) Security concerns: The Safety dialema Another major factor that is detrevent for women aspiring political voile is Security dialema. According to Amnesy Internation report (2019) Women officials often face homasment, threat and violence, creating an unsage environment to political engagement Cases like that of Benazir Bhutlo's public assassination during a political campaign underscores the severe risks involved for women in Politics. The lack of safe campaigning spaces and inadequate legal protection discourage many women from participaling in politics.
