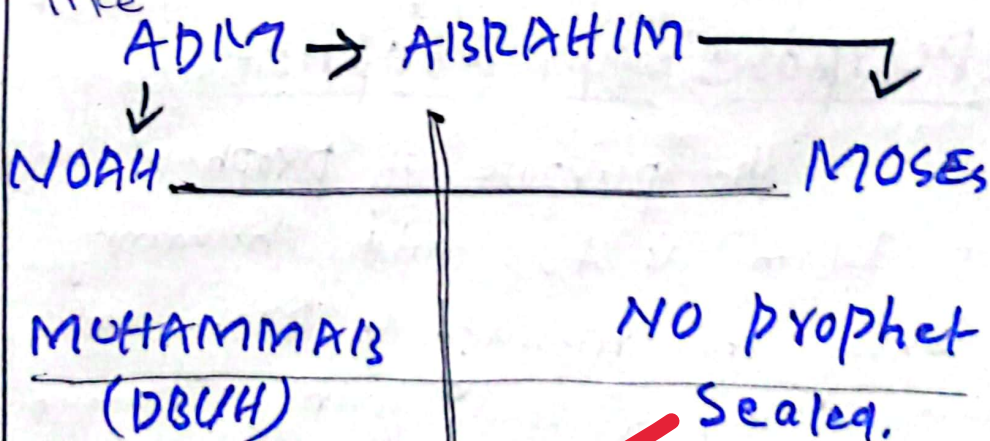

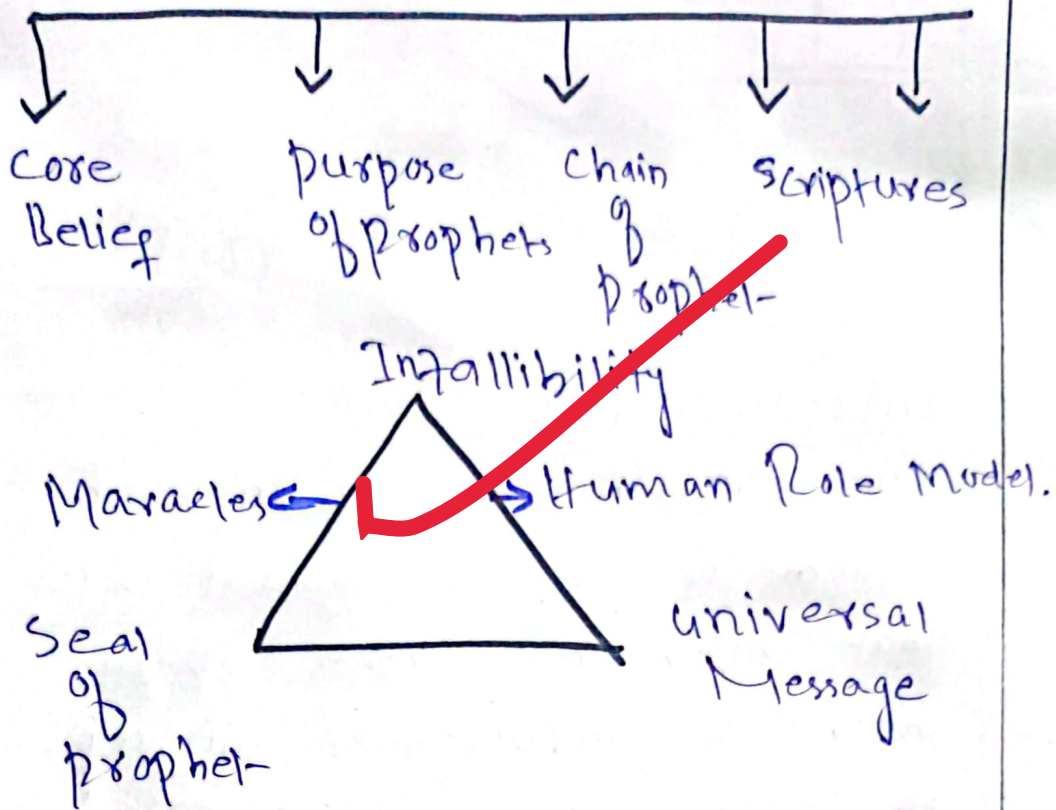

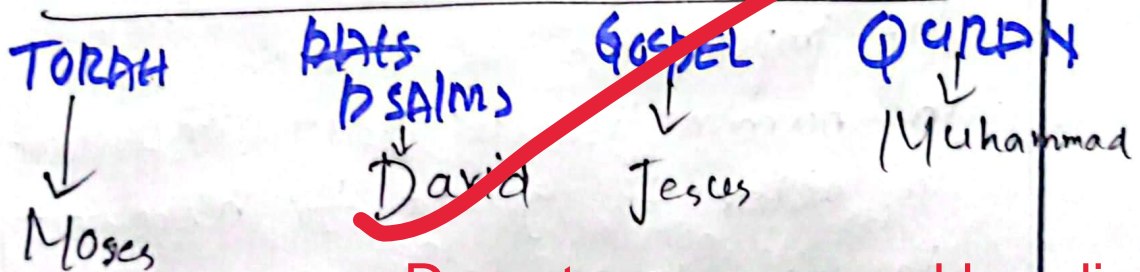
Chain of Prophet Chain of Prophet

Infallibility

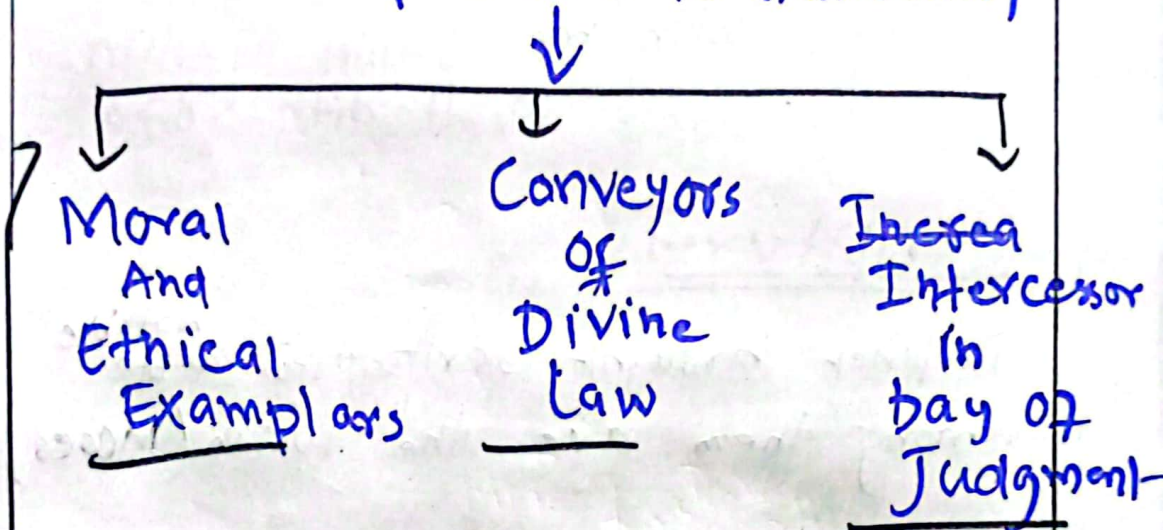
Prophets are considered ^{ma-sum} ~~ma-sum~~ (infallible) in their divine delivery of the divine message, free major sins.
