Indirect:-

4) Her husband said to her, "I shall not go to the office today as I am not feeling well".

Indirect:-

Her husband told her that he would not go to the office today as he was not feeling well.

5) My father has said to me, "I fear that you have caught cold again."

Indirect:
My father told me that he ~~had~~ feared that ~~you~~ had caught cold again.

6) His brother said to me, "I am not going to attend the meeting today."

Indirect:
His brother ~~told~~ me that he was not going to attend the meeting today.

7) The inspector said to the people, "We have caught the thief and he will be brought to book soon."

Indirect:
The inspector told people that they had caught the ~~thief~~ and he would be brought to book soon.

8) She said to her husband, "Whether

a) The landlord has said to the young man, "if you don't pay your rent by evening today you will have to leave the house."

Indirect:

The landlord told the young man that if he doesn't pay his rent by evening today he would have to leave the house.

b) His wife said to him, "Don't you know that my servant stole our money?"

Indirect
