The government, for instance, charges a man with treason, (acting against one's own country); obviously he's deprived of something essential to his freedom if the law is the acts which the government seeks to have accepted as treason. Here, obviously the judge ~~has~~ must be assured that this independence must be maintained with safety to himself. He must not suffer ~~within~~ ~~the~~ ~~power~~ in his person or position because of the views he takes. It must not be within the power either of the government or other persons to deprive him of his authority. because, as best he may, he applies the law. This, as I think, makes it essential that all judiciary appointments should be held during good behaviour. This may be an age-limit of services, of course; but again, apart, nothing should permit the removal of a judge from the bench except corruption or physical unfitness.
