Correct = Has either of you seen my pen?

→ ~~Each furniture~~ in this display is on sale for half price.

Each piece of furniture

Correct = All furniture in this display is on sale for half price.

→ Nothing but novels please me.

Correct = Nothing but novels pleases me. OR  
Only novels please me.

→ Neither he nor I are in the wrong.

Correct = Neither he nor I am in the wrong.

→ The population of Karachi is greater than any other city in Pakistan.

Correct = The population of Karachi is greater than every city in Pakistan.

→ Playing a game regularly is better than to read books always.

Correct = Playing a game regularly is better than reading books always.

→ After finishing my lecture, the bell rang.

Correct = The bell rang after finishing my lecture.

→ My friend is ill. I hope he will die soon.

Correct: My friend is ill. I fear, he may die soon.

→ I must walk two miles to school every morning when I was a child.

Correct = I ~~had to~~ walk ~~two miles~~ I have to walk two miles to school every morning when I was a child.

→ After the storm, we had got to pick up some fallen branches.

Correct = After the storm, we had to pick up some fallen branches.

OR

★ After the storm, we got to pick up some fallen branches.

→ Guitar is most popular instrument among teen age boys, but not girls.

Correct: Guitar is the most popular instrument among teenage boys, but not among girls.

→ You are not well and I wish you feel better soon.

Correct You are not well, but I wish you to feel better soon.

OR

You are not well, but I hope

you feel better soon.

→ The grass not looking green now because it is not raining since last month.

Correct = The grass does not look green now because it has not rained for last month.

→ The cold air made me shiver a little when I was waiting for him.

Correct: When I was waiting for him, the cold air made me shiver a bit.

OR

The cold air made me shiver slightly when I was waiting for him.

→ I offered my seat to an older woman who smiled me.

Correct: I offered my seat to an older woman who just smiled at me.

→ She packed her bags, carried downstairs and put the back seat of her car.

Correct: She packed her bags, carried them downstairs and put them at the back seat of her car.
