Before addressing the solutions, it is important to find out the root causes of political instability in Pakistan.

The chief among them is military interference in politics.

This interference disrupts the democratic fabric of Pakistan.

History is witness~~ed~~, that Pakistan has faced four

martial laws. Day-by-day our democratic institutions are

becoming weak and military interference is becoming strong.

According to Ishrat Husain,

Zia-ul-Haq promised to hold elections within 90 days,

but for him 90 days were equal to 11 years. He was

enjoying his term and did not want to transfer power

to a democratic government

(Governing the Ungovernable, 2018).

Hence, military intrusion in politics is one of the major cause of political instability.

Besides, military interference in politics, another reason of political instability is lack of awareness of public rights. In Pakistan, public has no proper ^{awareness} about their political and legal rights. Even many Pakistanis are unaware about their fundamental rights. State's supreme responsibility is to protect the fundamental rights of its citizens; but it is only possible when public has (aware) knowledge about their basic rights. According to newspaper The Nation, our politics has driven by personal interests because people are not aware about their fundamental and political rights. They are weakening the country in the race of weakening one another ("People lack awareness about fundamental rights", Aug 26, 2023). Therefore, unconsciousness among public about their rights leads to unfair politics.

In addition to ignorance about public rights, the judicial system of Pakistan is not competent. When judiciary is not independent, the instability in every department peaks such as in politics.

Judicial system of Pakistan now a days is a question mark for everyone, because it is not working independently. The ex-PM of Pakistan; Imran Khan feels fear about his life, as the judicial system is unable to hold free and fair trial of his cipher case (Dawn News, Imran Khan fears for his life, Oct 28, 2023).

Hence, in Pakistan justice is delayed, that shows the incompetence of judiciary of Pakistan.

When there is no independent judicial system; there is no effective system of accountability. National Accountability Bureau is not working.

In this way, the system of accountability is not effective in Pakistan. ✓

No doubt, poor system of accountability is one of the leading problems in politics, but it is due to our cramming based education system. ✓ Pakistan lacks an education system, that holds productive critical thinking skills. ✓ There are number of articles of content generate, which states that the main problem of education sector in Pakistan is outdated curriculum and lack of critical thinking skills. ✓ In this way,

the education system of Pakistan, fails to generate competent political leaders who can lead our country. Due to non-potent education system, the opposition in the government is not playing a positive role. In many developed countries, opposition plays a very effective role and guides government in policy making. While, in Pakistan opposition members are bullying the government. They are just doing negative things, which have damaged the political and democratic fabric of the country. This negative role was seen in the fight between members of Parliament in 2020. This shows, that in Pakistan opposition is not playing an effective role. The parties that are known as opposition parties, are not

playing their positive role, due to which we are facing an economic downfall. Economic downfall in Pakistan is also as a result of frequent switch of policies. Some governments in Pakistan are preferring nationalization and others are in favour of privatization. History of Pakistan is witness of this. According to an article of Mehboob Hussain; due to nationalization policies of Bhutto, the GDP of Pakistan dropped to 2.86% ("Z.A Bhutto policy and its implementations", 2021). In this way when one government changes into another due to political instability, there is a huge impact on economic condition of a country.

When there is an economic instability in a country; then there is much dependence on foreign aid. Pakistan's economy is also dependent

on foreign aid and loan.

There is a close relation between economic and political instability because when we are taking loans from other countries and international institutions, we are not able to take independent political decisions.

For example; IMF asks Pakistan to follow the structural adjustment program; if Pakistan wants to get \$3 billion loan to support its crippling economy (IMF, \$3 billion loan approval for Pakistan, 2023). Hence, due to political instability our country is facing economic downfall.

When a country is depending on foreign aid, and is not able to make independent decisions; then there is an arise of civil war in a country. Civil wars have a negative impact on the economy of Pakistan. Pakistan is also

facing a situation of civil wars, on which country's large amount of wealth is wasted. For example: PTI protesters, when ^{were} protesting after Imran Khan's arrest, the government has spent many resources and wealth to control them. In this way, civil wars that are resulted due to political instability have destructive impact on economic condition.
