But it is less hateful (نفرت انگیز) than other contemporary forms of Government and to that extent (اس) (نظریہ) that the individual (تہذیب کو جنم دیتے ہیں) it deserves our support. It does start from the assumption (نظریہ) that the individual is important and that all types are needed to make a civilization (تہذیب کو جنم دیتے ہیں) it does not divide its citizens into bossers (حاکم) and the bossed (محلوم) as an efficiency regime (آمرانہ حکومت) tends to do (کرتی ہے). The people I admire most are those who are sensitive (حساس) and want to create something (تخلیق کرنا چاہتے ہیں) or discover something and do not see life in terms of power and such people get more of a chance under a democracy than elsewhere. They find religions great or small or they , produce literature and art or they do disinterested (عدم دلچسپی) scientific research or they may be what .is called ordinary people who are creative (تخلیقی) in their private lives, bring up their children decently (اعلیٰ طریقے سے) for instance or help their neighbours. All those people need to

express themselves; they cannot do so unless society allows them liberty to do so and the society which allows them most liberty is democracy. (E.M.Foster)
