

Defamation Law: wave of unrest
 Pakistan ranks 159 in World Press Freedom, which is disappointing for a country that grants right of freedom of speech in its constitution. To make the situation more worse, Punjab assembly has hastily passed 'the defamation law' in five days. Defamation is defined as false publications or spread of information to damage someone's reputation. This law restricts social media platforms, printing press and electronic media from misleading people. While, social media author, opposition parties, and human rights activists recorded their protests against law for violating freedom of speech.

The law proposes that, the case of defamation will be decided in 180 days. Along with this, if allegations of defamation proved, the person will be liable to apology and blocking of social media accounts. Jury reserves the right to impose

charges of ~~3~~^{three} million rupees without trial, and the judgment can be challenged in ~~30~~^{thirty} days. If law not postponed, it may lead to further discomfort in the country.

Recognition of Palestine

Palestine was already recognized by ~~the~~^{one party two} members of United Nations, is now acknowledged by European countries: Norway, ~~Denmark~~, and Spain. Poland has also showed hints to admit ~~its~~ Palestine's statehood. Notably Israel's support by U.S. is of no favor to it, as the majority of the world population seems to oppose its inhuman activities. Admittedly, United Nations General Assembly adopted resolution with ~~the~~^{one forty three} votes in favor of Palestinian membership to UN, which was further forwarded to UNSC.
