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ISKP

since its formation in 2015, it has been influencing south Asia's ISKP experiencing resurgence after the US withdrawal of US-troops. The ISKP ambitions can be divided into two phases, the first is to gain the territory and consolidate control (from 2015 - 2019) In 2019, ISKP itself was facing intense pressure and lost territorial control. In 2020 onwards it has shifted its aim towards Urban warfare. And they did lethal killing attacks in Urban areas of Afghanistan.

The recruitment of ISKPs was done from the Pak-Afghan border. But after the takeover of Taliban in the Afghanistan, the pattern of recruitment

has been changed. Now, they are involving militant group on the pretext of Taliban betrayed Jihadi cause, and there is only one ^{viable option} group (ISKP) left to be associated with.

ISKP is trying to broaden its geographical scope. In Afghanistan, they bombed Nangarhar jail (11 suicide bombers). In 2020 attack on Nangarhar Jail, carried out by 11 suicide bombers, 1000 of prisoners were released, including 280 ISKP members. These attacks on Afghanistan had been increased after the exit of US troops. In 2020, the attacks rate was 83 and (the attacks rate was) 934 in 2021. Also, they have attacked on Ostanbal airport, death rate was 170.
