Introduction

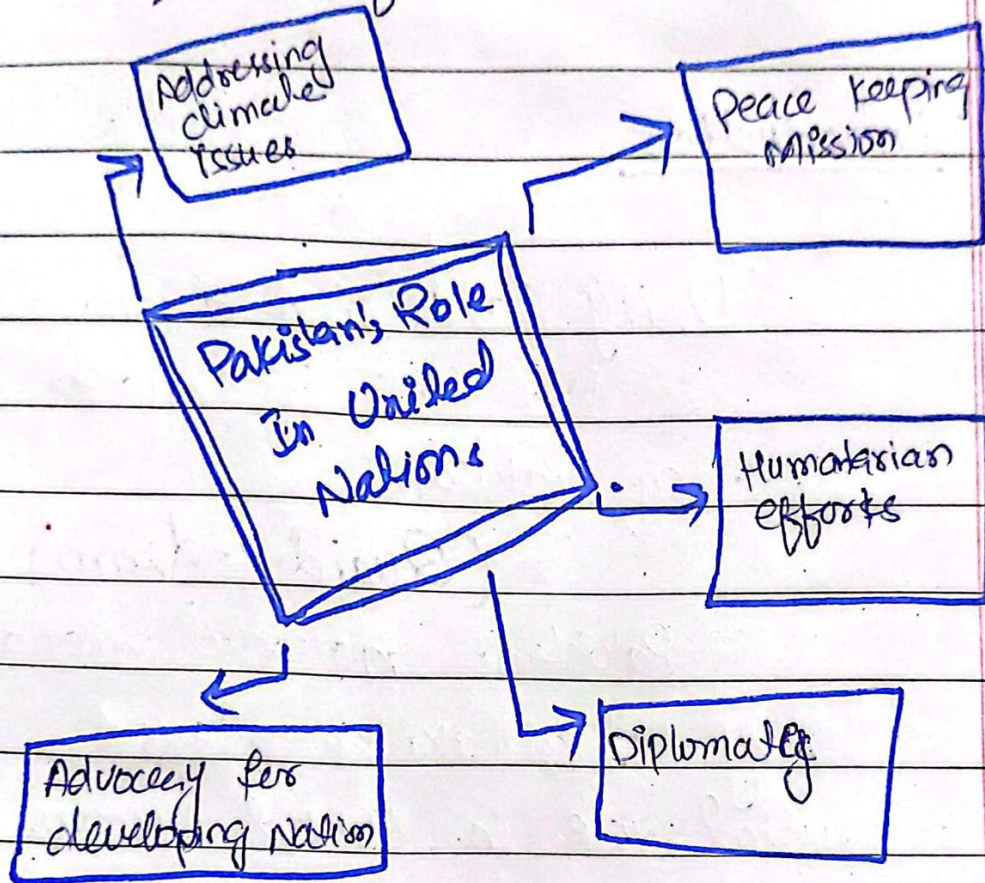
"Unity, Faith and discipline is the national motto of Pakistan"
