### I- Introduction:-



The belief on the oneness of God solve all the perplexing problems of human society and establish a new order wherein equity and justice, as well as peace and prosperity will reign supreme.

## 2- Impact of belief of Oneness of God on Human life:-

Tawhid has following impacts on human life individually and collectively:-



## 2.1) Tawhid Creates sense of Accountability

Tawhid encourages man to work according to the will of God. Tawhid creates sense of responsibility towards other people.

Dr. Khalifa Abdul Itakim in his book "Islamic Ideology" describes the essential derivatives from belief in God.

## 2.2) Tawhid Infuses self-respect

Tawhid produces highest degree of self-respect in humans. The believer knows that Allah is the possessor of all the powers, provider of his needs, which make him independent from all the worldly powers.

## 2.3) Tawhid gives purpose of existence to man and Universe:

The purpose of human creation is compatible with their supernatural creation. Human beings' acknowledgement of God and their consequential struggle in life to realize the purpose of their creation is a process of their own self-fulfilment more than anything else.

(Al-Kahf 17:15)


## 2.4) Tawhid Induces Sense of Modesty and humility

Tawhid makes a person unostentatious and unpretending. A believer never becomes proud and arrogant: Because he knows, whatever has been given to him is from Allah.

## 2.5) Tawhid imparts consolation, satisfaction and hope:

Tawhid imparts consolation, fills the heart of the believer with satisfaction, and provides hope to the person.

## 3.- Impact of Tawhid on society:



### 3.1) Human Equality and Social Equity

Tawhid is not a metaphysical concept. This is the only yard stick to measure the rank of man. It is the fear of God.

"بِحَبْلٍ لِّذِيْلٍ وَالْفَرْقَادِ"

"And hold fast by the covenant of Allah Altogether and be not disunited."

(Al-Imran 3:10)

### 3.2) Islamic Unity, Brotherhood, Bond and Mutual Cooperation

Tawhid is grounded in human responsibility, socio-political and economic accountability and universal justice.

The Holy Quran says:-

إِنَّ الْمُؤْمِنِينَ أَخْوَةٌ ۝

"Certainly, all Muslims are brothers."

(Al-Hujurat 49:10)

Prophet (PBUH) says:-

"When one part of the body is ill, all other parts of the body share this illness."

A poet has beautifully said:-

3.3) Tawhid promotes collective peace and social Justice

Islam connects Tawhid to socio-political and economic justice. Injustice leads to disruption of peace which must be confronted and corrected.

### 3.1) Secularization and Modernization:

Secularization refers to the transfer of authority from religious institutions to secular ones.

Modernization has led to a decline in religious beliefs and practices. As Allama Iqbal said:

### 3.2) Scientific Advancement and Rational Thinking

Scientific discoveries and advancements have led to a decrease in religious beliefs. Many people now rely on science and reason to explain the world, rather than religious teachings. As a poet has said:

دُنْيَا کیا ہو جائیں تو حکومت کیا ہو جائیں

### 3.3) Increased Focus on Individualism and personal Freedom:

As people have become more individualistic, they are less likely to follow traditional religious practices and more likely to create their own personal beliefs and practices.

### 3.4) Rise of Pluralism and Multiculturalism:

As societies become more diverse, people are exposed to different religions and beliefs. This has led to a decrease in religious exclusivism and an increase in religious tolerance and acceptance.

### 3.5) Criticism of Religious Extremism:

Religious extremism has led to criticism and rejection of religion by many people. This has contributed to a decline in religious affiliation and practice.
