You discussed the why part, but not the applicating the Darekground behind Introduction of Continental System after 1806 Rise of France as a Major Victorious state in Europe: Napoleon introduced Continental system after 1806 mainly due to rise of France as a major victorious state in Europe. Its one of the best example is of Italian campaign 1796 in which



- and Austrians in 1796 and remained victori-- ous. France realso acquired territorial gains after these victories and by signing Treaty of ampo Formio in October 1797.

Series of Victories of France against Austria Continental system was introduced after 1806 due to series of victories gained by France against Austria before 186. Battle of Marengo and Hohenlinden fought in 1800 are best examples of French victories after which treaty of wneville was signed in 1801. Moreover, France also remained victorious against combined armies of Russia and Austria in Battle of Austerlitz in 1805.

Rise of France as a Major Countering Force against Great Britain France introduced continental system after 1806 mainly due to rise of France as a major countering force against Great Britain before 1806. Battle of Ryramids of 1798 is a major event in this regard. French army fought against Malmuk forces and became victorious in acquiring control over Egypt. This was intokrable for British as it



was a threat to British naval supremacy in the Mediterranean. > Growing Rivalry between Franch and Great Britain One of the main reasons that contributed to introduction of continental system after 1806 was growing rivalry between France and Great Britain before 1806. Battle of Nile in 1798 and Battle of Trafalgar in 1800 were noise events in this regard, in which naval engagement was won by British Royal navy to disrupt Napokons plans in the Mediterranan. Due to this tussle between 18 two great powers before 1806, continental system was introduced on November 21, 1806. Napokon's continental system of 1806 failed due to numerous reasons, some of which are enlisted below.

-> Poor Administration of Napoleon:

Poor administration of Napoleon in continental system led to failure of this economic system because smuggling allowed British goods to enter in continental markets, thus circumverting Napoleon's intended economic isolation of Britain. This smuggling disrupted the balance of trade and goods in continental markets. > Shortages of Groods in Europe: Due to disruption of trade in Europe after continental system there were shortages of goods in Europe that led to failure of continental system. In response to European boycott of British commerce, Britain imposed an efficient blockade on European coast to block latin America's and west Indies market for Europe. 50, there were shortages of coffee, tea, sugar and cotton in Europe

Irrational Policy of Napoleon: Napoleon's policy in continental system was irrational as his apploach was e France first approach? His economic administration was France centric. This led to failure of continental system. If the whole Europe was seen

as a single entity and France was not given the whole importance in development for of industry and economic progress, continental system could have worked. **Rise of nationalism** -> Obsession of Napoleon with Britain Installing outsiders on The key reason for introduction of anavarsustemacy of system was obsession of Napokon wettglabolitain and it was the same reason that led to its failure. Because while introducing this system Napoleon ignored the fact that Britain was ahead of France in industrial Rubbertion and it was impossible for France to replace the British industry. Moreover, during this period British national income rose from 14 million pounds to 335 million pounds, while rest of Europe was suffering with shortages of goods > Economic Kecessions in Europe: Continental system failed due to economic Reessions in European countries after this economic system. There were ressocion of economic activities, disruption of trade, poverty, chronic unemployment and shortages of goods in Europe due to irrational policies of Napoleon in this economic system here economic recessions of Europe ultimately led to failure of continental system.



> Strain on French resources: For implementation of continental system, France needed resources like naval patrol, custom officials and administrative infrastructure. This strained French resources and distorted Napoleon's attention from other important iskues like military campaigns and domestic governance. This ultimately led to failure of continental system. CONCLUDING HOUGHTS Napoleon introduced continental system mainly to counter British economy and reducing its Strength to wage war against France. But it had reverse repermissions as this system had strengthened British economy-According to Andrew Roberts, Napoleon's Continental system was a dumay intrument of economic workare
