 people. While, social media author  
 opposition parties, and ~~philis~~ <sup>philis</sup>,  
 human rights activists recorded  
 their protests against laws for  
 violating freedom of speech.  
 The law proposes that, the case

 100 days. Along with this, if  
 allegations of defamation proved,  
 the person will be liable to  
 apology and blocking of  
 social media accounts. Jury

charges of <sup>three</sup> million rupees without trial, and the judgment can be challenged in <sup>30</sup> ~~20~~ days. If law not postponed, it may lead to further discomfort in the country.
