Salient Features of Islam:

Islam is a deen which provides
complete code of life. Following are
salient features of Islam.

1) Unique Concept of Tauheed:

Islam provides w with unique concept
of tauheed. It means faith in oneness
of God, To believe in superiority of
Allah Almighty. It is our first part
of kalma tayyaba.

لا اله الا الله

"There is none worthy of worship"

In Surah Ikhlas Allah says;

قل هو الله احد
الله لا اله الا هو
لم يلد ولم يولد
لم يكن له كفوا احد

"(say he is Allah, the only one, Allah the one. Taking care of everything He didn't give birth and He was not born and he never has any equal at all);

Famous scholar Allama Shibli Naumani wrote in his book (Sirat ul Nabi) that Hazrat Muhammad (p.b.u.h) said:

"(Tawheed is first chapter of Islam's syllabus.)"

② Aqeeda-e-Resalaat (Prophethood)

The second most significant feature of Islam is Aqeeda-e-Resalaat; belief in finality of Hazrat Muhammad (p.b.u.h). It is second part of Kalma Tayyiba.

Hazrat Muhammad (p.b.u.h) ^{رسول الله} is the Messenger of Allah. ←

Hazrat Muhammad a beacon of light for all Muslims, his life is practical example of Quran which teaches us toward straight path.

P.b.u.h says:

"verily I have been sent as a teacher to mankind"

③ Islam is a complete code of life:

Islam is a complete code of life. It provides guidance in every aspect of life. It guides us in our individual life by providing rituals, faiths and beliefs. Islam emphasizes the importance of education according to Hazrat Muhammad P.B.U.H.

"Education is compulsory for every man and woman"

It also guides us in our social lives by providing rights of relatives, rights of neighbours. It also leads our political life by providing system of "Khilafat". Quran says:

"Determine affairs by consultation"

It also provides us financial guidance by providing system of Zakat and Ushr.

④ Islam promotes humanity:

Another guiding feature of Islam is that it promotes humanity. Advocates for rights of human as well as animals.

It emphasizes on values of sympathy, tolerance and social welfare.

once Hazrat Muhammad scolded a Bedouin man for not properly treating his camel.

Hazrat Muhammad also ordered for sustainability and protection of environment.

He said;

Don't cut trees and don't waste water even if you are sitting on a running stream.

⑤ Principle of Equality:

Islam is a staunch proponent of principle of equality. Islam emphasizes that in eyes of Allah Almighty, people are equal. It does not allow any discrimination based on sex, race, origin and soon.

In Quran Allah says: "No Arab has any superiority over a non Arab, nor does a non Arab has superiority over Arab nor does a white man have superiority over a black man, or the black man any superiority over the white man."

⑥ Holy Book (Al Quran)

All Muslims believe in the holy book of Al Quran, Quran is considered the literal word of Allah Almighty revealed on Hazrat Muhammad (p.b.u.h). It is primary source of Islam's theology and law. Quran is guidance for all mankind and for all ages. It provides guidance in every field.

Al Quran Says;

"This Quran is Enlightenment for mankind and Guidance and Mercy for people who are certain in Faith"

"Quran is Guidance for Mankind (Al Baqrah : 185)"

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Islamic Explanatory Readings

Islam has its own system of Law and order derived from the teachings of Quran and Sunnah. It covers both religious and secular aspects of life. It provides laws for crimes, for family for justice etc. Muslims can draw solutions for Law and order of Shariah.

It also gives concept of Ijma; A secondary source of Shariah of collective Reasoning among authoritative Muslims on particular issues.

According to Hazrat Muhammad (p.b.u.h) "My Ummah will never agree on an error".

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Five pillars of Islam:

Shahada (Faith) It is declaration of faith inness of Allah and prophet hood of Muhammad (p.b.u.h).

2) **Salah (prayer)** performing ritual prayers five times a day, it connects Muslim with Allah.

3) **Zakat**: Islam orders Muslims to give Zakat (charity) (2.5%) of total wealth yearly to help needy and poor, it cleans wealth of Muslim and decrease accumulation of wealth in few hands.

4) **Fasting**: Observing fast in Month of Ramadan. It is another important pillar of Islam. It teaches Muslim patience, simplicity and value of blessings.

5) **Haji (pilgrimage)** undertaking a pilgrimage to Mecca atleast once in life time if one can afford.

⑨ **Faith in day of Judgement:**
Faith in day of Judgement is important feature of Islam. It is belief of all Muslim that one day this immortal world will end and Day of Judgement will happen and on that day All ~~human~~ individuals will be held accountable for their actions and rewarded or punished accordingly.

In Quran Allah said:

أَلَمْ يَجْعَلْ لَكُمْ يَوْمَ الْقِيَامِ

"on that day you will be brought to judgement and none of your secrets will remain hidden,"

⑩ Moral and Ethical conduct:

Islam promotes values such as honesty, justice, compassion and humanity. It prescribes guidelines of social conduct, social justice and community welfare. prophet (p.b.u.h) upheld justice and fairness in all aspects of life and taught us to do the same.

According to Hazrat Muhammad (p.b.u.h)

"The best among you is one whose conduct is good,"

⑪ Sovereignty of Allah:

Islam teaches that sovereignty belongs to Allah Almighty Alone and humans are his representative on earth and he is accountable to Allah Almighty.

Allah is superior and sovereign who is all knowing and seeing. He is the master of the universe and day of judgement; In Pakistan Constitution it is given that sovereignty belongs to Allah Almighty.

In Quran Allah says

"It is he who is the

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Faith in All prophets and previous Books

Islam teaches us to believe in all prophets Allah has sent towards mankind and the books revealed on them. All Muslim have firm believe in All prophet from Hazrat Adam to Hazrat Muhammad (p.b.u.) and the previous holy book such as Taurat Injeel, Zabur and the Final Quran Kareem. All Muslim follow Quran Kareem as it was revealed on prophet Muhammad and is guidance for all mankind whereas all other previous books are changed by their believers and not in their original forms.

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Resurrection after death:

All Muslims believe in Resurrection after death, day of judgement and Reward and judgement.

It is our firm believe there will be an eternal life, people with good deeds will be entered in paradise as a reward whereas people with bad deeds will be sent to hell as punishment. Surah Al Qayamah which chapter of Quran describes "The Rising of dead"

Faith is Al Qadar: It is Islamic belief that Allah already knows everything that will happen in universe. Allah has already decided our fates. He already knows everything and nothing happens unless it is according to Allah's will.

Duran says; (No kind of clarity occurs except by Allah's permission)

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System of Khilafat:

Islam provides an Islamic form of government in which political and religious leadership is united. The head of the state is successor of (P.b.uh). Islam provides very clear instruction for selection of Caliph. He should be Muslim, a leader, a man of wisdom and unquestionable credibility etc.

"The Caliph is a shepherd over people and shall be questioned about his subjects"

(Al Duran)
