Deen covers all aspects of life, individual as well as collective. In other words, deen is an all embracing term which includes religion - socio - politico - economic systems. It touches upon the material as well as spiritual dimensions of human existence. In this regard, Islam is not only a religion but also a deen as it is a complete code of life. According to Dr. Khalifa Abdul Hakim:



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Islam means peace as well as submission... The purpose of life is to live it well; in other words, wellbeing. The purpose of life is life edified, harmonized, enriched, strengthened and elevated." He further went to say that "The craving for peace is inherent in human nature; hence being naturally for Islam of peace."

2) Role of deer in human life and society.



It tells us how to live a virtuous life, how to conduct ourselves in public or at home, how to treat parents, relations, friends, strangers, the poor and orphans. It instructs us about economic, social, educational and political ends. Concept of Religion (Mazhab):

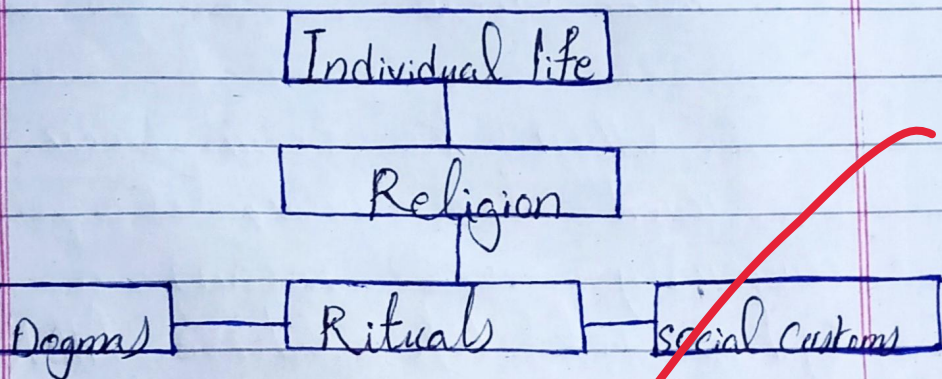
a) Literal meaning of Religion:

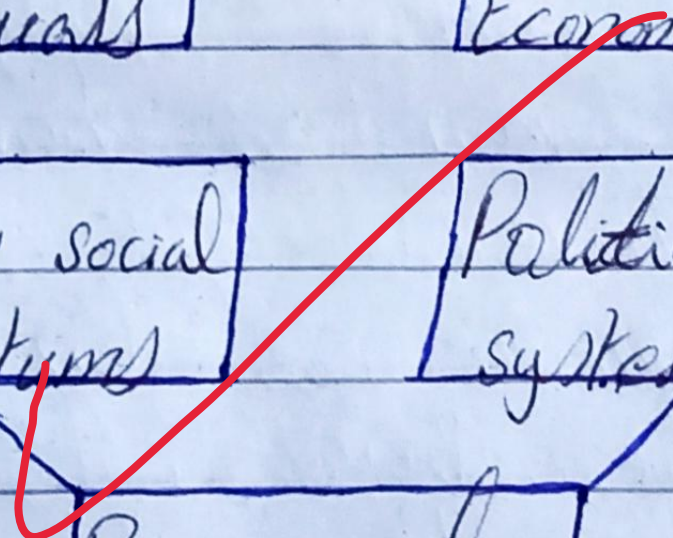
