United Nations ^{was} established ^{on} 24th October 1945, after the world war II. The Primary Objective of United Nations is to promote peace and security ~~internall~~ internationally, among nations. There are six main organs of United States in which its works which are, The Economic and Social Council (Ecosoc), The Trusteeship Council, Secretariat, The International Court of Justice, The General Assembly and Security Council.

With the help of these six organs United Nations can ~~due~~ ^{oversees} sanctions, ~~overseeing~~ the Economic and social issues, discuss them and try to resolve them. There are 193 members of United Nations.

There are 54 members of Economic and social council and these members are being rotated after 3 years. The Economic and Social Council mainly works on, ^{coordination} ~~Coordination~~ of US Agencies, Economic Development, Social development, Humanitarianism Affairs, Environmental sustainability, Trade and Development, Global health, Human Rights and (etc)

Capacity building. It is one of the main organ of United Nations.

The Trusteeship Council is one of the principal organ of United Nations in which United Nations funded Trust the until they deemed ready for self government. The Trusteeship Council ~~plays~~ ^{has played} decolonization process by overseeing the trust territories ~~itself~~ ^{been} government or Independence. The Trusteeship system has mentioned in Chapter XII of UN Charter, The Trusteeship Council played crucial role in the mid of 20th Century but now it is inactive.

Secretariat is led by the Secretary General of United Nations, ~~in~~ ^{with} the tenure of Secretariat is only 5 five years and the Secretariat ^{secretary} is appointed on the recommendations of Security Council. It oversees the day-to-day activities including Implementing decisions, Coordinating activities, and managing peace keeping operations.

The International Court of Justice is main principal judicial organ of United Nations in which the function of International Court of Justice includes, to settle legal disputes between states. States may bring their issues voluntarily to ~~the~~ International Court of Justice by accepting its jurisdiction or including by clause their treaties the conventions stipulating that stipulate dispute will be referred to the Court.

The General assembly is the largest organ of United Nations in which there are 193 members. Every member has right of vote only on any Resolution or decisions of the General Assembly. The General assembly serves as, forum for member states to discuss and coordinate international issues, make recommendations, addressing global concerns, and promoting cooperation.

In Security Council there are only 15 members in which 5 permanent members (USA, UK, China, France, Russia) and 10 non-permanent members having 2 year term
