Q1: Critically Analyze the Salient Features of Plato's Republic. Do you think that some of its features are valid, even today?

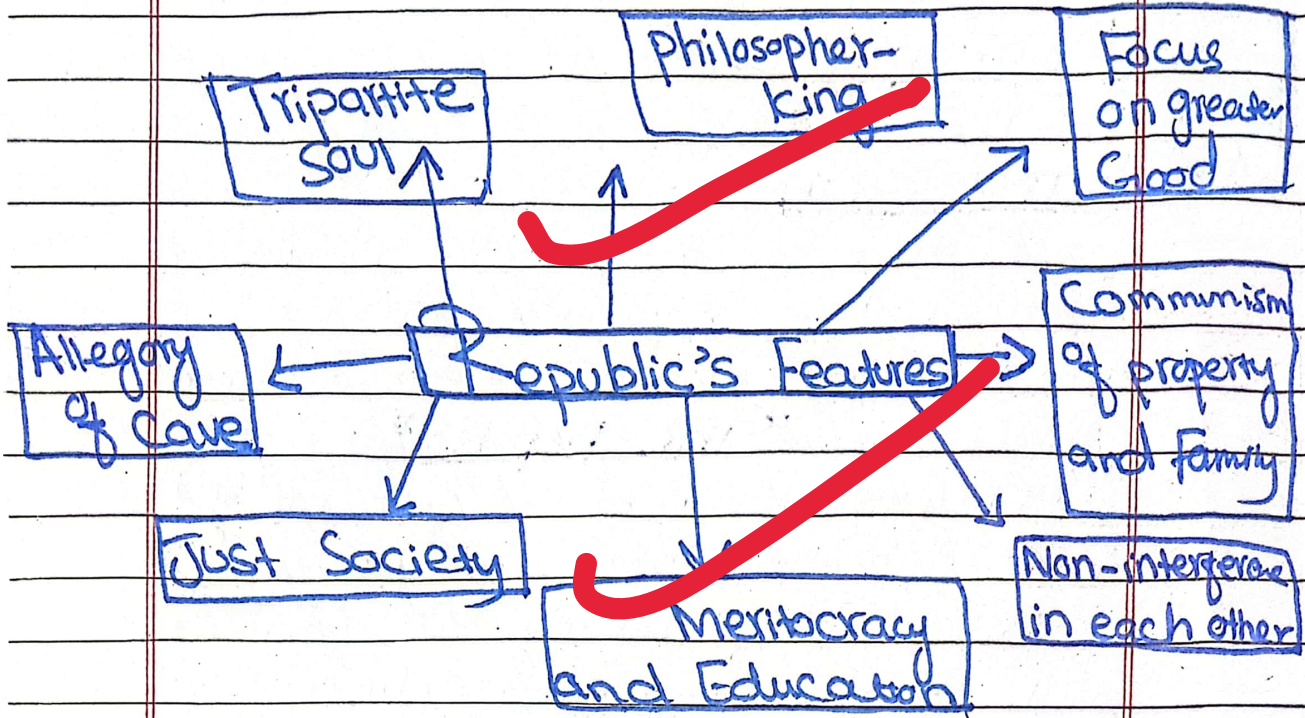
Answer
