This is sub-optimal considering the diverse tourist sites located across the country. Pakistan attracted 16 billion US dollars in visitor spending in 2022 which is projected to touch 30 billion dollars in 2033.

Pakistan experienced an unprecedented surge in domestic tourism immediately after the Covid induced travel restrictions were lifted. For instance in 2021 and 2022, 1.2 million domestic and international tourists visited the country. Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province alone. But some restriction in the way of growing tourism in the country that limit it from growing.

There are multiple challenges to the tourism industry in the country to grow. These include security issues, poor infrastructure, lack of political will, poor management, disintegration between center and provinces, complications in documentation and lack of participation of private sector.

Security challenge is one of the most important challenges to the tourism industry in the country. There are multiple factors behind the security issues in the country. Terrorism, extremism and sectarianism are rampant in the country. Terrorism, extremism and sectarianism emerged in the country since 1979, when Soviet invaded Afghanistan for vested interest. It was the cold war era politics of power. There were two world circles at that time in the world.

Capitalism and communism. USA came in the region and stepped up in Afghanistan to counter the communism and Pakistan supported Taliban on behalf of the USA against the Afghan government. It gave birth to terrorism in Pakistan. The situation further deteriorated following the global war on terrorism. It badly hit the peace and stability of the country. Although it ~~was~~ is recede but completely not addressed. As per interview of Imran Khan, ex-PM of the country, 85,000 people lost their lives in this war and the country suffered a loss of 150 billion dollars while we have received aid from USA only 30 billion dollars. It created a terror storm in the country which led the country economic, political and social instability.

Pakistan declared terror state by world analysts. Tourism industry completely collapsed in terrorism. People don't visit the country owing to the security situation.

Consequently, tourism could not grow due to security issue in the country.

Similarly, poor infrastructure road, rail and transport and lack of connectivity among the provinces and center is another major hurdle in the way of growing tourism industry. Further, traffic signals are not in functioning position. Poor road and infrastructure including transport lead to frequent accident and casualties which has bad effects on the tourism industry. Further, untrained drivers drive vehicle even without license that can lead to any untoward situation and it will block the flow of traffic which

Further, the country has not introduced policies to attract the tourists from foreign and domestic. Already available laws regarding tourism industry are obsolete and outdated and

As in January 2022 thousands tourists visited the Murree. According to traffic authorities 15,500 vehicles entered Murree and 13,500 vehicles returned safely and some 1000 vehicles blocked the way and the snowfall was started. Due to blockade heavy snowfall 08 people killed in their vehicles due to shortage of oxygen. All the responsibility lies on the traffic department that a place able to park

Complication in documentation is another barrier in the way of tourism industry. Foreign and domestic tourists have to face many complications in receiving certificates and visas. Unnecessary condition imposed in receiving visas.

Further, lack of e-visa policy is another hurdle in the way of tourism. Pakistan is far from digitalization compared to other countries like India that has introduced e-visa policy for the tourists.

According to reports, in January 2019 the rent increased by the contractors up to 70000 due to this the situation became unstable that took the lives of 20 people. Private participation will decrease, the rent of the rooms and the system will run more smoothly.
