And after 20 years, they abandoned the practice of Satti themselves. It shows how education changes mindsets. But in Pakistan the main hurdle in education is unemployment, poverty, inequality, discrimination, unequal distribution of resources.

Pakistan is being ranked at 52nd on the list of world's poorest countries. (IMF). In tribal areas, people often lacks access to basic infrastructure, food etc. so education is not a priority for them. Almost 22 million children are out of school. unless, Pakistan address these issues of education, it cannot paved its way towards progress. Because it is the only solution of uprising our nation, if Pakistan would deal it then only innovation will be there. which would help in national progress.





Due to corruption, Pakistan was added in grey list of FATF (Financial Action Task Force) in 2018, which shaken Pakistan economy badly. Because it eroded trust of foreign investor, and deteriorates the picture of Pakistan globally. Also, due to financial money laundering and terrorist financing, incident of terrorism has been rising since 2006. According to the report of Pakistan Institute of Peace Studies:

So, weak institution, lack of transparency, hinders effective counter-terrorism measures and prevails the incidents of terrorism, corruptions, bribery and so on.
