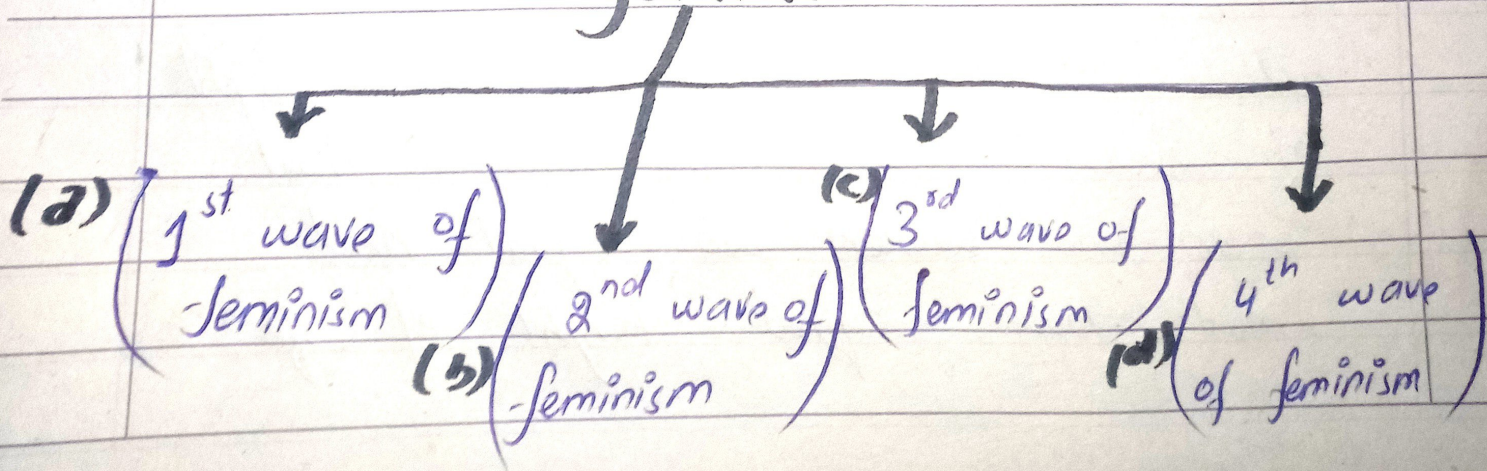
Word "feminism" was derived from the word "femina" means "the women"

Waves of Feminism



First Wave of Feminism

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(1848 - 1920)

Background:-

- Before the first wave of feminism. The women were considered weak. It was thought that the women always needed to be protected & guided by the man.
- During 1848 Seneca fall Convention. About 200-300 people (including men and women) first time discuss women's issue in this Convention. It was the beginning era when the women issues were highlighted.
- But actually 1st wave started during French Revolution when the freedom of women and Liberalization was discussed. 1792 - Mary Wollstonecraft wrote an article "A Vindication of the Rights of Women" where she discussed that men and women are equal. And must have equal Right of Life.

Introduction:-

Oliva band in his book: "Becoming a feminist" discuss the social origin of first wave feminism. First wave of feminism was about the legal right and right to property.

Objective.

Key feature of first Wave of feminism

- (a) Discrimination: 1st key feature of this wave to abolish discrimination among male and female on the bases of their Gender. There must be equal Right for men and women
- (b) Freedom: Freedom is the only option to remove the discrimination or freedom is the solution of women's issue
- (c) Equality: Equality between men and women in all aspect of

of Life.

Contributors of First Wave of feminism

(a) Mary Wollstonecraft:-

Mary Wollstonecraft write a book "A vindication of Right of women" in (1792). In this book she talk about women. She said men and women are equal in intellect. therefore, both both must have equal Right in politics and other field.

(b) Susan De Anthony:- "1848" she gave a speech on "An incident of illegal voting". When she discussed that the group of women attacked on polling station and caste illegal voting. Police arrested those women one of them was Susan de Anthony. After arrest she delivered this speech.

(c) Virginia Woolf:- She write "A Room of one's own", in this Book she discussed bisexuality of women.

(d) Simen De Beavoir: She wrote a Book "Second Sex". In this book she criticised the concept of otherness for the women.

Leading Activist

The leading activist who was leading this wave of feminism were Susan de Anthony, Simon-Beaurd, Virginia woolf, etc.

feminist Organization & Movement

- 1848 - Seneca fall Convention (where first time women's issues were discussed)
- 1869 - National women Suffrage Association was established in USA for political Rights of women.
- In UK - John stalt mill gave a prosel to the lower house of Common but defeated
- In 1903 - Women Social and political Association was established in UK for women Right.

Achievements

- 1893 - Newzealand gave Right of Suffrage (Right to vote) to the woment.
- In 1920 - in 19th Constitution - amendmew USA gave Right to Vote to women

- 1918 - Britain passed "The Representation of people Act" - in this act UK gave the right to vote to the women.
- Women / married women property Right Act was passed in 1870.
- Right of Education was also gave to the women.

Criticism

- it Confined the middle class women.
- it Just ~~talk~~ talk about legal Right of women (Right to vote and property Right).
- Limited influence.

Conclusion

Feminist Rise voice for their legal fight for it and get their legal Right. it was a door step for Second and third wave of feminism. it was a foundation stone for gender equality. women have achieved legal Rights due to first wave of feminism.

Third Wave of feminism

→ **Plurality and Diversity:**

Being different is not abnormality. 3rd wave of feminism demand to

Accept the LGBT (Lesbian, gay, Bisexual and Transgender). Queer also must be accept.

→ **Transversal Politics:-**

Nira Yuval-Davis write a book "Gender and Notion" (1997). Here she discussed about Transversal politics. There must be possibilities of dialogues between women of different Religion, Nationality and Caste.

Feminist :-

→ **Rebecca Walker:** She write a book "To be Real". Here she discussed about women issue. on the basis of race, culture etc.

→ **Judith Butler:-** She write a Book "Gender trouble and body that matter". In this book she demand to accept transgender and Queer and LGBT group.

Major Achievement

→ **Rise of LGBT:-** LGBT publically demand their acceptance. They demand do not consider themselves others.

→ No Sisterhood But Women Solidarity :-

Not a single culture determine the plight of the women of other culture. In order to determine this plight one have to experience the other culture.

→ No Compromise identity of other :-

Every women have own identity. No compromise on the identity of a women will be compromised on behalf of other.

→ Diversification of feminism

feminism became more diversified. Black feminism, post modern feminism added.

Legal Rights:-

- Some Legal Right also achieved
- 1992 - 4 women Senate appointed in US Senate.
 - 1993 - family and medical leave act was passed
 - 1994 - Merital Rape - declared illegal and violence against women Act passed.
 - 1992 - four world Conference on women in UN was organised.

Third wave of feminism gave Rise to LGBT group. So many entrined was against it.
