entangled with various challenges.

started his mission in Makkah

Once Hazrat Muhammad was performing ibdat in Kabbah, the camel of Abu Jahil poured on him. Listening this news Hazrat Fatima^{ra} run towards Muhammad to clean the dirt of camel.

(iii)

The rude behavior of Jaif

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The people of Taif teased Hazrat Muhammad a lot. When Hazrat Muhammad wanted to inform them that,

"There is no God except Allah."

The people of Taif turned against him and threw a stone on him and his companions. However, Hazrat Muhammad showed an excellent level of tolerance. On this occasion his companion asked him to curse them, Hazrat Muhammad said,

On the same occasion, when the blood of Hazrat Muhammad fell in his shoes, Allah sent an angel

to crush the people of Taif between two mountains. However, Hazrat Muhammad asked for the mercy on them. Hence, these all occasions showcased that Hazrat Muhammad worked on the principle of
