What type of language would be used?

↳ As simple as possible

↳ Clarity is more important than fancy words.

↳ Should be awamri zaban.

Don't write so that you can be understood,

Write! so that you can't be misunderstood.

↳ Essy esa likhen k jesy prhny wala apky.

samny betha apki bat sun rha ho - Clear

↳ You ~~are not~~ presenting ~~to~~ a PhD scholar but a common man. So, keep your handles on simple English only.

What are the instructions for good Essay?

- ↳ Make outline
- ↳ Write comprehensive Essay.
- ↳ Write your observations, readings with great narrative skills (exposition, argumentation and discussion)
- ↳ Organization
- ↳ Relevance (only related data)
- ↳ Clarity (next person should pick the exact meaning)

outline → Thesis → Topic Sentence → Coherent & tangible arguments.

↳ one sentence (because of logic)

↳ main idea of the paragraph

↳ always prove your stance whatever it is - doesn't matter.

- ↳ Quote reference only where applicable (no extra reference should be added, there is no need to add stats and numbers everywhere in the Essay).

- ↳ 3 themes (every Essay will be one of the three)

Types of Essay

Expository

- ↳ Simple explanation
- ↳ Informative piece of writing
- ↳ ① Comparison & Contrast
- ↳ ② Cause & effects
- ↳ ③ Problem & Solution

Levels of exposition

- ① Global
- ② Third world countries
- ③ Only Pakistan Relevant

Argumentative

- ① Agree / disagree
- ② You have to take only one stance of two
- ③ Yes / No

Once you take it, stand by it - !

eg:- Feminism is not really a third world's issue

Literary / Relative

Explanatory

but the statement would be very confusing

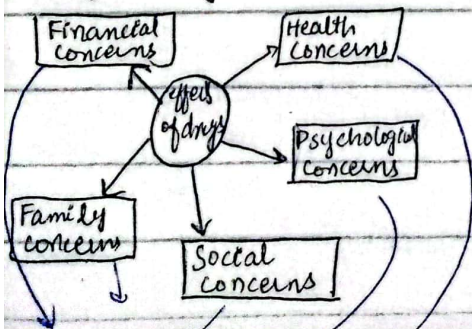
→ How?

How to write an expository essay?

Brainstorming

- ↳ Prewriting, irregular ideas about the topic
 - ↳ Gathering ideas that are not aligned
- eg:- Harmful effects of drugs



Outline

- ↳ Collect ideas the abrupt points / ideas as a theme
- ↳ Arrange them all to write a paragraph on each -

- eg:-
1. Health concerns
 2. Psychological concerns
 3. Social concerns
- so on.

Paragraphs

- ↳ Introductory paragraph including thesis statement in it:-
 - ↳ Next paragraph like
- para - 1
- para - 2
- para - 3
- so on.

Distribution of words:-

Total = 2000 - 3000 words

Introductory paragraph 100-150 words
(5-10% of Essay)

Conclusion paragraph 100-150 words
(5% of Essay)

Other/Body paragraphs (60-70%) 1500 words
(300 per para)

Question paragraph (optional) 150 words - 200
(5-10%)
↳ why this happens?
↳ But its just to maintain length of Essay.

1. Introduction (10%)

- a. Hook / Attention Grabber
- b. General Statements / Background:
- c. Thesis statement: No doubt it's a rising monster because it creates strain on infrastructure, scarcity of resources, socio-economic problems, environmental hazards and serious management crisis in third word, specially Pakistan.

2. Main Body (60-70%)

1. Reasons making increasing Population

a. Rising Monster / Why is it considered a rising monster? (60-70%)

- a. Strain on Infrastructure: Hindering the development of roads, schools, housing hence making it a rising monster.
- b. Scarcity of resources: Water, gas, energy, land, food crisis.
- c. Environmental Hazards: pollution, deforestation, extreme weather, water scarcity.
- d. Management crisis: law and order problem traffic.
- e. Socio-economic issues: increasing poverty, illiteracy, unemployment, class difference.

2. Reasons behind Ignoring the issue / Why is it the least addressed issue? (5-10%)

- a. Poverty: More hands, more income, security and old age insurance
- b. Illiteracy: absence of efficient human resource, skilled population, misinterpretation of religion
- c. Sheer Apathy of Government: priority difference
- d. Global need: works professionals, from 3rd world.

3. Recommendations to Address the Issue. (5-10%) one para required (Obligatory)

3. Conclusion: - (5%)

- a. Thesis using different expression
- b. Summary of the Ideas Presented
- c. Final thought or prediction (You may add quote or verse(s)).
