The war against terrorism not only harmed the peace but also resulted in the deaths of children, women and old age people. In short, war on terror contributed to mass casualties of humans.

The war on terror also created sectarian based violence in the middle East. The Western nations such as EU and the U.S created proxies and changed regimes in Iraq. The alignment with Shia based rulers in Iraq resulted in sectarian violence among the two sects of Islam. Reuters investigated the issue of sectarian violence. According to the Reuters resistance groups of Sunnis emerged in Iraq which boosted the violence. This is how war on terror harmed the world.
