"Israel, with Egypt's help, has turned Gaza into an open air prison," said by Omar Sharh, the director of at Human Rights watch. The horrific Israel Palestine war has accelerated again when Hamas attacked Israel on 7 October 2023. Since then, Palestine is being exposed to the intensified brutality of Israel. Although, it has been a century since Israel has had started to occupy the territory of Palestine, particularly the Gaza strip. However, the recent conflict has met the poor Palestinians with wreck havoc. The ongoing war is the consequence of some major events, took place back in 20th century. Particularly the Balfour declaration, Arab Israel conflicts and UN resolution. Subsequently, Israel has subjugated the innocent civilians and doomed the region with its punitive actions. It imposed the greatest humanitarian crisis that includes the forced displacement, blockades, mortality, water and food scarcity. Besides, the illegal use of white phosphorus and airstrikes on hospitals and refugee camps by Israel's army lend credence to Omar Sharh's description of the region as an 'open-air prison'. The international organizations also seem fail to combat against this toxicity of Israel. All these human right organizations and countries particularly the developing ones like Pakistan struggle to be effective due to the significant influence of USA. However, the implementation of certain measure can potentially resolve the Israel Palestine conflict.

To begin with Balfour declaration, it is one of the root causes of Israel's ^{illegal} subjugation on Palestine. On 1916, after the first world war, the Britain declared the Palestine as a new homeland for Zionists. Since then, the Jewish community started to penetrate in Palestine. Almost 60,000 Jews reached to Palestine at the time of Balfour declaration, says **Moscow** an Israeli journal.

This is how the Jews began to settle in Palestine.

The Balfour declaration had a profound impact on middle East. As a result the inception of Israel took place in **1948**. The Jewish community proclaimed its independence from British. And forcibly occupied the Jerusalem as their capital.

The foundation of 'Israeli state' put a great stress on Arab neighbourhood countries. The Arab Israel war continued from time to time till now. The first war dated on 1948-49 followed by **1956, 1967, 1973, 1982, 2006** and **2023-present**.

To resolve this conflict between Arabs and Israel, the United Nations passed a resolution 181 (II) in 1947. However, this resolution did not work as the Israeli Army ~~continues~~ has had continued to siege the Gaza. Similarly, the forced displacement of Palestinians has reached to its highest level. Since Hamas's October 7 attacks in Southern Israel, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has threatened to turn

Gaza into a "deserted island" and warned its residents to "leave now", Al-Jazeera. Besides, the Israeli army keeps the residents deprived of basic fundamental rights that include, right to get education, food and shelter. As per Aljazeera 87 percent of school buildings and more than half of Gaza's homes are damaged or destroyed, making the life difficult there. 16 years of Israeli Blockade^{also} made the condition of Palestinians more worsen. Since 2007, Israel has maintained strict control over Gaza's airspace and territorial waters and restricted the movement of goods and people in and out of Gaza.

Along with that, the severe humanitarian crisis is imposed on Gaza which is leading the conflict towards a more complexity. The high level of mortality is being witnessed in the history of this genocide. As per media reports more than 43000 people are brutally killed in this war, including nearly 16,765 children and more than 10,000 missing. The number of casualties is increasing with each passing day. According to Aljazeera reports "every hour in Gaza 15 people are killed, six are children." moreover, the suspension of drinking water and food scarcity also threatening the lives over there. Food insecurity affects 70% of Palestinians and they^{have} become dependant on food aids, which hardly reach there due to the blockades of Israel's military. The Prime Minister Natin Yahu is reluctant to end this war therefore he did not hesitate to permit airstrikes on hospitals and refugee camps. There has been

reports of an Israeli airstrike killed at least 14 people, including two children, when it hit a UN School sheltering displaced Palestinian families in Central Gaza. Similarly on 3 November 2023, amid the Israeli invasion of the Gaza Strip and Siege of Gaza City, an Israeli air strike hit an ambulance convey departing from al-Shifa hospital carrying injured patients. The strike killed 15 people and wounded 60, NPR. The unlawful usage of "white-phosphorus" has also been done by Israel. White-phosphorus is a chemical substance which can burn the skin to bone. It has short-term as well as long-term impacts that can exacerbate the injuries, and ^{even} death can occur. This is how Israel's sleazy and immoral activities endangered the lives of in Gaza strip.

In contrast, the world's response seems to be diplomatic. The two greatest political and international organizations, UN and OIC, respectively can not bring an ease or cease the war. UN found to be helpless in front of the hegemony of 'US-backed Israel'. The political and economic influential of United States ^{of America} on global politics, hampered the peace process. Members of OIC could have done given a 'noticeable' favor to their Muslim brothers in Gaza who are going through a brutal and chaotic war. However, the dominant member states ^{of OIC} have strategic or economic ties with USA therefore they fear to support Gaza in its real essence. USA herself is a founding member of UN thus possessing veto power, which

she used drastically in denial of cease-fire. which she also used in imposing sanctions on different states which tried to oppose USA or stood against her in past. This is the very reason, the countries can not go against Israel, particularly the developing countries like **Pakistan**. It can not afford the enmity of USA, hence limited herself itself to record ~~to~~ its protests. Without indulging in deepest measures to stop the war.

In spite of all the hardships, there is always a silver lining in every cloud. Implementing certain and timely measures can resolve this belligerence of Israelis and Palestinians. The local boycotts alone can not combat with Israel. It needs a great and sincere attention of Human Right organizations along with developed countries to review the agreements, resolutions and policies to sort out this problem. It should be stopped at any cost otherwise this conflict can be a factor ^{begin} to World War III. As already, ~~the~~ it estalated the grievance of the residents of Middle East. Not alone the middle east but the people of South Asia ^{also} showing the hate and anger for Israel. The two state resolution by United Nations, needs to be imposed immediately otherwise the regional war would turn into the global war.

To conclude this essay, the humanitarian crisis imposed by Israel on Gaza, has indeed turned this region into an open-air prison. The history of this war can be traced back
