The main purpose of this experiment was to determine the effect of temperature on the rate of reaction between potassium dichromate and potassium iodide. The reaction was carried out at three different temperatures: 25°C, 35°C, and 45°C. The rate of reaction was measured by the time taken for the color change to occur.

The results of the experiment show that the rate of reaction increases with increasing temperature. This is because the molecules have more kinetic energy and are therefore more likely to collide with sufficient energy to overcome the activation energy barrier.

The following table summarizes the data obtained from the experiment:

Temperature (°C)	Time taken for color change (s)
25	120
35	60
45	30

From the data, it can be concluded that the rate of reaction is directly proportional to the temperature. This is in agreement with the Arrhenius equation, which states that the rate constant increases exponentially with temperature.
