

The Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) is a regional intergovernmental organization founded in 2001 in Shanghai. It evolved from "Shanghai Five" group, established in 1996. It includes China, Russia, India and Pakistan among its 10 members.

→ What it Entails?



According to the SCO Charter, the organization seeks, "to promote regional peace, security, and stability and create a new international political and economic order."

► Significance it Holds:

As stated by the former president of Kazakhstan,

"The leaders seated at this negotiation table are representatives of half of humanity."

The SCO, with 80 percent of the Eurasian landmass, and 40 percent of the world's population, holds the largest regional cooperation globally. The SCO's control encompasses 20 percent of the GDP, 20 percent of the world's oil reserves and 44 percent of natural gas. This emphasizes the colossal significance of this organization.

c. Cultural Exchange


The SCO promotes mutual understanding among its diverse member states. The recent meeting included discussions on expanding cultural programs.
