It perceives Islam as a threat for the global peace and stability. This hatred and prejudice against the Islam can only be vanished if muslims fulfill their responsibilities. The west thinks/terms fear of islam as Islamophobia. It has linked Islam with terrorism and sectarian extremism. West sees Islam as anti-women religion. Similarly, west has declared Islam advocate of social

inequality. Moreover, west takes Islam as anti-science and conservative religion. This adverse perspective of Islam has various causes that include misinterpretation of Islam, lack of cohesion among muslim ummah and ineffectiveness of OIC. However, muslims have ability to portray Islam as positive religion. For this purpose, muslims have to launch ~~strong~~ strong anti-islamophobia campaign to eradicate prejudice against Islam. Similarly, muslims need to change their conservative mindset by advancement in science and technology and ensuring women rights. Another step may be educating others true spirit of Islam. Moreover, adoption of seerat-un-nabi and promotion of unity among muslim ummah can have far-reaching impacts in this regard.

In a nutshell, the negative image of Islam in the western world requires muslims efforts to improve it. This image has been prevalent due to misinterpretation of Islamic ideology and its principles. However, this image of Islam can only be made positive, if muslims realize and fulfill their duties and responsibilities.

Islamophobia is the most commonly perceived image of Islam in the west. This fear of Islam in west has numerous causes that include misunderstanding about Islam, linkage of terrorism with Islam, rising influence across the world etc. Hatred against Muslims and their religion has observed huge/exacerbated in the past few years. Muslims, particularly in west are experiencing prejudice and discrimination in every aspect of life. Islamophobia is ^{being} manifested in the forms of hate speeches, social boycott, and even violence. Council on American-Islamic Relations documented shocking 182 percent increase in bias motivated incidents targeting Muslims between October and November 2023. Hence, this ~~is~~ shows that west has perceived Islam in the form of Islamophobia.

Another image of Islam that is prevailing in

western world is that Islam supports terrorism. This notion emerged due to the brutal activities of some militant muslim groups. Muslims are identified as terrorist in western countries who mercilessly kill unarmed and innocent people including children across the world. The **9/11 incident** is considered most pertinent precedent in this regard in which world trade centre in USA was targeted. The attack was launched by Osama bin Laden who was a muslim. Similarly, **Daish, Taliban** and other **militant** organizations have been involved in multiple terrorist attacks globally. To conclude, it can be said that some muslim militant groups have distorted the peaceful image of Islam across the globe.

created in west is that Islam is an anti-women religion. It is due to the intense restrictions imposed on women in the name of Islam. The proponents of this viewpoint opines that women are considered inferior to men in Islam. ~~also~~ Islam has deprived women of their basic rights of education, employment and freedom. **The Afghanistan** which is a muslim state has imposed **ban** on the education of women. Similarly, doors of employment have been closed on them. Women cannot move freely these women have been deprived of leadership positions. Such sorts of measures in a muslim state have created various misconceptions about freedom of women in Islam.

Sectarian extremism is another factor that has played a key role in shaping image of Muslims in the west. Muslims are divided into two major sects, Sunni and Shia. Both these sects are based on contradictory beliefs, values and practices which has often resulted into extremism against each other. Sectarian extremism has given birth to a negative perception about Islam and its followers globally. Saudi Arabia and Iran are two major countries that are leading sunnism and shiaism respectively across the Muslim world. This sectarianism has resulted into various proxy wars between the both countries. Wars in Syria (2011), Yemen (2015) and Iraq are the pertinent example of sectarian extremism. To recapitulate, the sectarianism has portrayed

extremist picture of Islam across the west.

Moreover, Islam is seen as the anti-science religion in the western world. It is considered that scientific inventions and discoveries are against the teaching of Islam. Some Muslims do not use medicines as they termed it haram!

Similarly, some/few groups of Muslims ^{think that} ~~are~~ mobile phones and social media are ^{merely} the source of vulgarity and moral degradation. Similarly, contribution of Muslim world in the development as well as in the invention in the field of science and technology is like a drop in the bucket.

Muslims have forgotten to follow the footsteps of renowned Muslim scientists like Jabar bin-Hayan, Al-Biruni, Ibn al-Haytham, Al-Khawarizmi etc. Therefore, west has considered Islam as anti-science religion.

Another image of Islam that is predominant in west is that Islam is an advocate of social or gender inequality. In muslim culture, male are usually breadwinners, while women are responsible for childcare and domestic duties. Similarly, women have to cover their body in Islamic society that is perceived as oppression, on women and raise questions about personal freedom and choice. West claims that Islam is a conservative religion.

In Pakistan, particularly in the tribal areas of KPK and Balochistan, intense restrictions are imposed on women, leading to social inequality.

In a nutshell, west sees Islam as a religion of propagating social inequality.

These are multiple reasons behind negative image of Islam in western world. The foremost reason is the lack of unity among muslims. Disputes within the muslim community such as sectarian violence and desire to rule the muslim world, have significantly contributed in portraying adverse image of Islam. Saudi Arabia is leading sunni bloc, while Iran is leading Shia bloc in the muslim world. This sectarianism has resulted into ^{various} wars between the both blocs. These internal divisions have overshadow the peaceful teachings of islam, showcasing the opposite perception of Islam.

Similarly, another supreme reason of negative picture of Islam in west is inefficacy of Organization of Islamic Cooperation. OIC was

established in 1969, and it consists of 57 muslim member states.

Its one of the important functions is to protect the true image of Islam. But, unfortunately, it has

failed in performing its duty. Every

other day, ^{the} cases of defaming Islam,

particularly in west, are reporting

but, OIC does nothing except passing resolutions and condemning these

heinous acts. The main reason

of its failure is the lack

of cohesion and unity among

member states. Due to internal

disputes, OIC members fail to

reach on consensus. To recapitulate,

it can be said that the

organization which was made

in the name of Islam, has now

failed to protect and promote

the positive image of Islam.

Although West has emphasized the negative image of Islam and Muslims, but this image can be altered only if Muslims perform their responsibilities in painting positive image of Islam.

These are various responsibilities of Muslim Ummah, chief among which is launching anti-Islamophobia campaign globally. For this purpose, Muslim leaders as well as Muslim scholars need to present peaceful image of Islam on international forums like United Nations. Prime Shehbaz Sharif

in addressing 79th session of United Nations General Assembly on 27 September 2024 expressed his concern over rise of Islamophobia

by saying that:

“Islamophobia is a global concern, and we must combat this scourge together.”

Hence, by collaborate efforts, Muslims can negate the

idea/notion ~~of~~ of Islamophobia.

Another responsibility of muslims is to grant all the rights to women that are bestowed to women in Islam.

Muslim ummah must/have to manifest the real status of women that is awarded to them by Islam.

It can only be possible by providing the rights of education, employment, marriage, property and freedom of speech ^{to women} within the islamic state. Infact, Islam is the only religion that has provided dignity and equal status to ^{both} women and men.

Holy Prophet (PBUH) said:

“I command you to be kind to women.”

Hence, it is the duty of muslim ummah to portray Islam as women-friendly religion.

Condemning extremism and terrorism is "another" core responsibility of muslim ummah to create positive image of Islam in western world. It is imperative to address extremist ideologies and actions that are contributing to negative image of Islam in west. It includes promoting the true, peaceful teachings of Islam. Islam has given immense importance to the life of human beings. According to Quranic verses: "Whoever kills a human being is considered to have killed all mankind. Whoever saves the life of a single human being is considered to have saved the life of all mankind". To recapitulate, presenting the anti-extremist and anti-terrorist ideology of Islam is the foremost responsibility of muslims.

In addition to it, Muslims have to create awareness and educate people ^{about} the real principles of Islam. It includes participation in religious debates, use of media for promoting Islamic ideology and manifest teachings of Islam by actions/conduct. Moreover, educational institutes can play key role in this regard.

Open mosques days is another way of educating others about Islam in which non-Muslims can visit mosques, ask questions and learn the Islamic teachings. Similarly, religious scholars hold a key position in creating awareness about misconceptions of Islam and promoting Islamic values. Mufti Menk is a renowned religious scholar who is using social media platform like YouTube and Instagram for propagating Islam. Hence, by educating ~~to~~ others, Muslims can improve their status.

Furthermore, contribution in the field of science and technology is another way to depict the true picture of Islam. For this purpose, Muslims need to alter their ^{conservative} mindset. Muslim countries have to allocate larger funds for Research and development. There is a dire need to establish research centers and universities that focus on innovation and research. King Abdullah University of Science and Technology (KAUST) that is located in Saudi Arabia, is providing platform for scientific and technological education and research.

To conclude, Muslims have to focus in the scientific and technological field in order to negate the idea ^{that is islam} ~~of~~ ~~anti-science~~ is an anti-science religion.

Moreover, these are various responsibilities of Muslim ummah, ^{but} the prime
