This issue has proved to be quite arguable and is one of the key agendas of present women rights movements across the globe.

Similarly, one such controversial issue of current women movements is the rights of the LGBTQ+ community.

Moving on, the me too movement that gained momentum in 2017 proved to be highly controversial and sparked great debate across the world. Many variants of movement took place later in the years around multiple countries in the world. As the me too movement focused on sexual harassment and assault, it had great public outrage and conversations about sexual misconduct. But this movement brought another controversial issue of due process attached with it.

The opponents of the movement believed that there was a lack of due process for the accused. It was argued that there is no legal process and that public accusations lead to reputational harm and has created an aura of "trial by media" with no legal basis.

It is believed that the allegations of 

misconduct are handled poorly and leads to irreversible reputational damage for the accused. This movement and the issues raised in it proved to be and to this day is extremely controversial. ~~It~~ Similar to LGBTQ+ rights, the rights of transgender women also played a crucial role in creating extreme polarized opinions, within women movements. It is highly debatable if ~~so~~ transgender women should be included in the agenda of women movements. Similarly, there is an increasing discourse about transgender women and their inclusion in women spaces, as they are not female by birth. In many areas around the world, there are separate public spaces for the third gender or for the gender less, non-binary. Though it may be considered a solution but it is also considered discrimination against a specific community. There is seen, an extreme split of opinions regarding this matter. Thus, this issue is also one of the many controversial issues raised by feminists in the women rights movements across multiple countries in the world especially U.S.A and Europe.

The legalization of prostitution and sex work also lands in the list of controversial issues of feminism in the contemporary feminist movements. In many countries around the world, prostitution has been legalized for example Netherlands, Germany, Switzerland, Australia, Mexico. Some have partial legalization and regulations. This is an on-going debate if the legalization is beneficial for the state and sex workers or is it exploiting their situations even more. The women movements (in various) and organizations in various parts of the world have different stances about this. Some believe that it is exploitative form the core and has been created due to patriarchal structures and can't be separated from human trading while pro-sex work feminist believe that it gives rights to the sex-workers, improve working conditions, removes the

stigma attached and empower women to take autonomous decisions about their bodies. Thus it is a controversial issue raised up by feminist movements in many parts of the world.

Another perspective to the controversial issues raised by contemporary women rights movements is the cultural and religious opposition (and the men's perspective) to the agenda of the movements. There is cultural and religious barriers to the demands of women in the feminist movements. There is a split among feminists about the undertaking of cultural and religious practices. For example many feminists believe that wearing a head scarf is oppressive and that it is a symbol of patriarchal control over women and their bodies. Proponents on the other hand believe that wearing a hijab or a burqa is a personal choice and respecting their religion and culture is also their right. It is their right to wear whatever they want without any force or coercion. This perspective also challenges westernized way of feminism and criticizes the stereotypes against muslim women.
