

Quadrilateral meeting at UNGA

Pakistan has attended a quadrilateral meeting with regional partners China, Russia and Iran at UNGA. The country has gained a diplomatic win by assuring its partners of having severe security threats from Afghanistan. The joint press at release from quadrilateral meeting demands urgent and indispensable action of Afghan de facto government against the militant organizations operating from their soil. The meeting was attended by the foreign ministers of all countries and Pakistan was represented by the Defense Minister. The foreign minister of China reiterated and assured unwavering partnership in wiping out terrorism and radicalism from the region. Moreover, all countries analyzed the success of BRI and other trade routes. Russian representative assured assured Pakistan and Iran of full support against growing atrocities of Israel in Gaza and Lebanon. The joint

meeting demanded urgent and unconditional ceasefire in the Middle East. Chinese representative showed his uncertainty over growing expanding war on the Arabian Peninsula. All leaders condemned the brutal killing of innocent Lebanese and Syrians and demanded UNSC of urgent implementation of recent resolution.

The leaders from all countries pledged to have unwavering commitment in neutralizing terrorism, collective future, and active diplomatic engagement. Moreover, Pakistan got assurance from all allies of successfully holding SCO conference in Islamabad which is going to hold in mid of October in Pakistan.
