

# Middle East at Threshold

The US and 67 countries supported the right of self-defence of Israel and asked PM Netanyahu to

retaliate in ~~calculated~~ way. It is no gainsaying the fact that Israeli attack on Iranian oil facilities will boost the oil prices and likely to create global energy inflation.
