Pakistan's Fragmented Unity

Anatol Lieven, in *Pakistan: A Hard Country*, suggests that Pakistan's army renowned for its discipline could only fracture under extreme moral and emotional pressure. The only scenario likely to cause such a division is a US invasion of Pakistan with no resistance ordered by the army command. This situation could lead to mutiny and civil war, but not a unified revolution. Regional and ethnic identities complicate Pakistan's political landscape, preventing unity behind any cause, including an Islamic revolution. This deep-understanding division, based on region, caste and religious practices, makes national unity a distant goal.

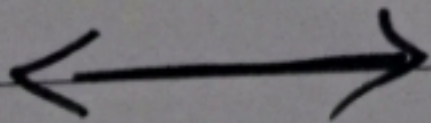
