① Introduction

Gender Studies and Women Studies are two academic fields discussing the issues faced by men and women along with other socially developed genders. These theories talk mostly about the rights of every gender with regard to discrimination in class, colour, race and ethnicity. Women Studies is an interdisciplinary study of women in a society. Whereas, gender studies is a multidisciplinary study focusing on men, women, LGBTQ and other forms of social genders. ② Difference between gender studies and women studies.

Gender studies and women studies are mostly considered as one theoretical concept, however, it is completely different. Both disciplines deal with different area of study, though both do merge in few points. The major differences are the following:

a) Evolution of Gender studies and Women studies.

Women studies was first officially initiated by San Diego University, USA in the year 1969. However, the debate on women dates back to many years, from women fighting for rights and then fighting to eliminate discrimination. Through time line, women studies found new dimensions and then men's studies took dominance as mentioned by

Famous author and sociologist Michael Foucault in his book "Gender Trouble" considers the formation of Queer Theory as a new vital discipline of our society. These newly constructed terms led to the formation of Gender Studies in the early 2000's. This theory defined the roles and issues faced by all the genders in our society.
