INTRODUCTION

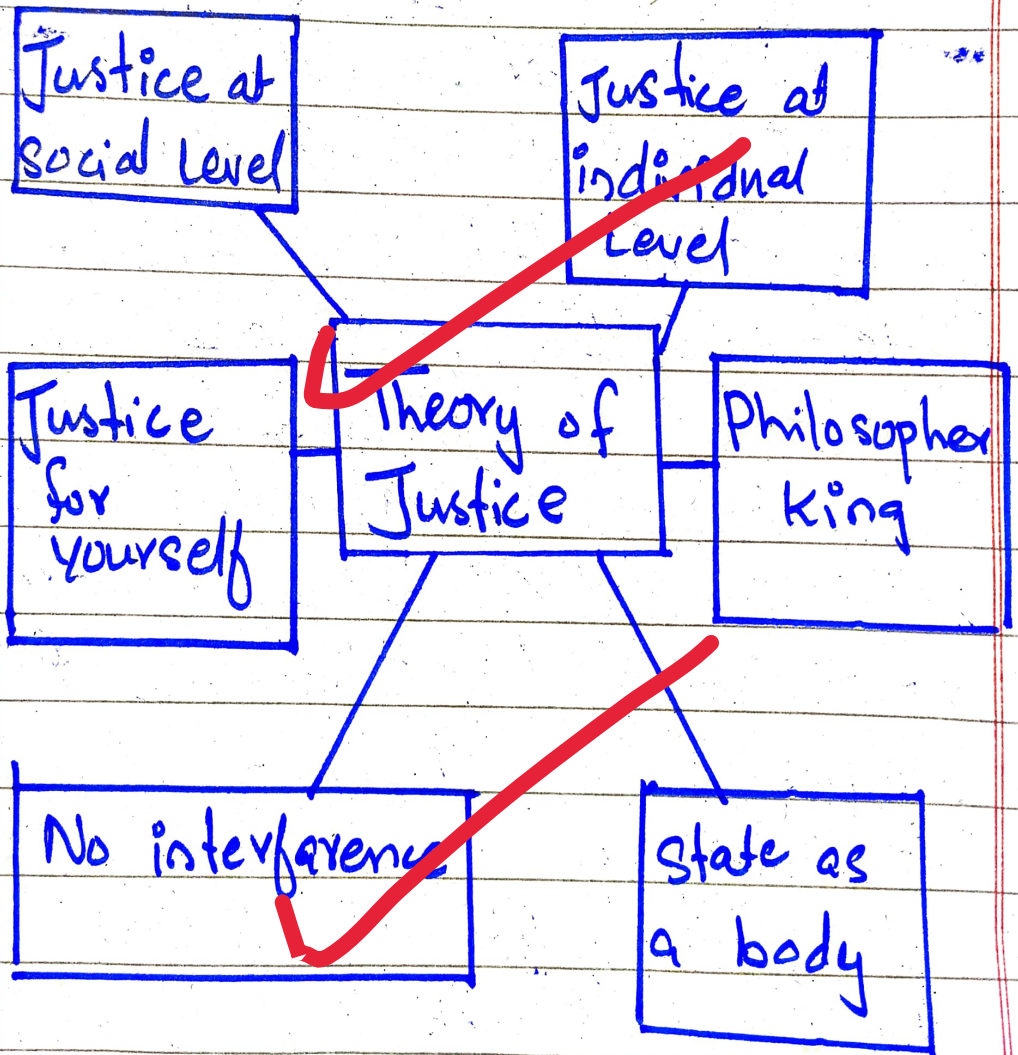
"Justice is the distribution of what is due to each according to his worth"

Plato's consider state as a body and its people are its organs. When people will be just so state will be

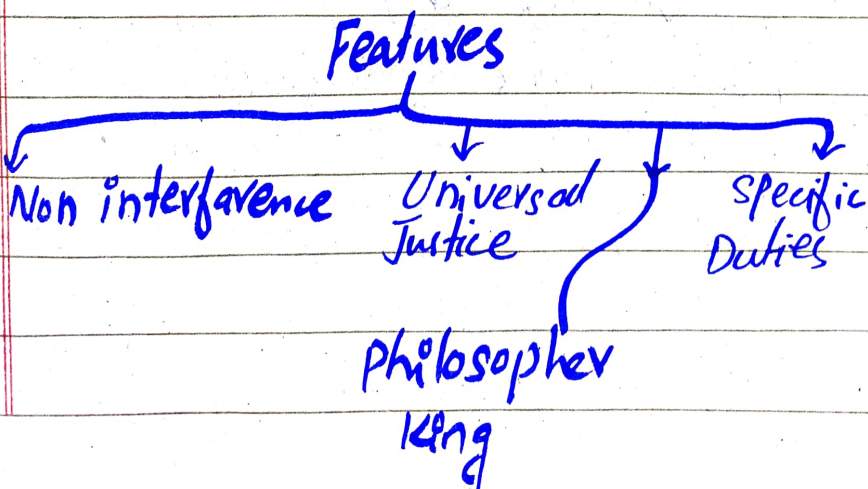
Justice. State is connected with every actions of people.
