

Dealing with Children.

Modern educationists **emphasize** the **adversaries** of not engaging with children, whereas they should enjoy their company. If one has liking for children, the same way one has liking for pets, the children will be more responsive without any reluctance. If one tries to inculcate in them a social behaviour and **expects** something from them in future, they will not feel gratitude. The desired interest is getting pleasure in their company without any purpose. Unfortunately, over-burdened teachers are unable to maintain natural liking for children. Their contact with children should not exceed two hours a day. Dealing with children gets tiresome without discipline. This causes obvious irritation despite teacher's efforts. More **self-control** cannot produce friendliness but where it exists, rule about controlling naughty children ~~should be~~ avoided because no rules can replace affection.
