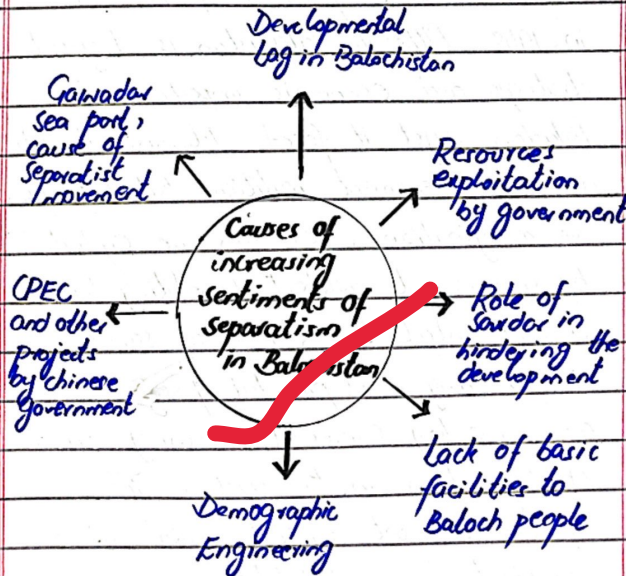
1/ Introduction

Balochistan has seen many uprising fighting for autonomy and independence since it became province of Pakistan in 1948. Although Balochistan is of great strategic and economic importance for Pakistan, it has faced Islamist, jihadists and pro government militias. Baloch people are marginalized, resources are exploited by government without benefiting locals, developmental lag, role of sardars in censoring developmental programs are some key causes of increasing notion of separatism in Balochistan. The government must negotiate with Baloch people to bring stability in region.

2) Causes of increasing sentiments of separatism in Balochistan



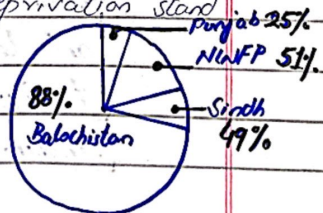
(A) Developmental lag in Balochistan triggering separatist movements

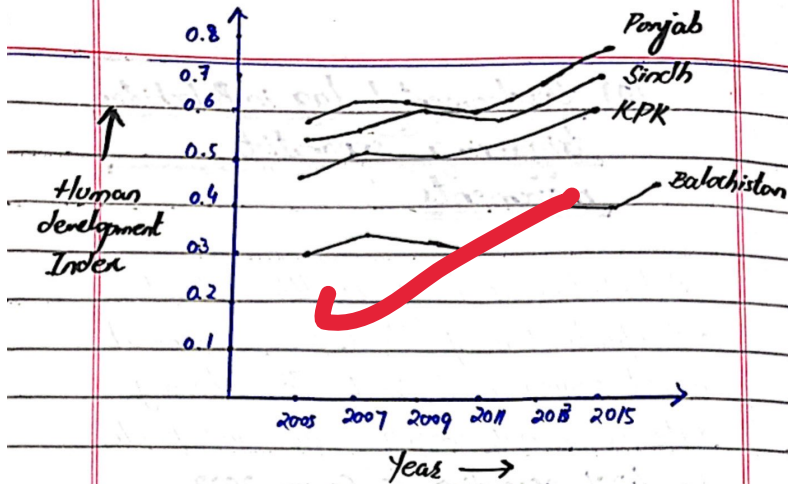
Balochistan is facing health, education and infrastructure problems, since government is not paying heed to it. The literacy rate is lowest among males and females i.e. 42% according to Census 2023.

(B) Lack of basic facilities to Baloch people causing separatist sentiments

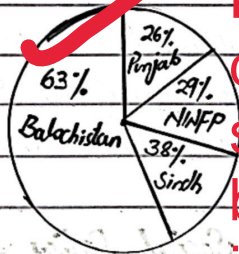
Many areas in Balochistan face lack of health facilities, like water, food electricity. This aroused in Baloch people a sense of alienation and separatist movement.

According to Social Policy Development Center 2005 report, percentage of population in highest deprivation stand highest in Balochistan.





According to Poverty related report by Pakistan institute of development and economics (PIDE), poverty is highest in Balochistan, and lowest in Punjab

(c) Resources exploitation of Balochistan by government and less amount being paid to Province is causing separatist sentiments to rise in province

Balochistan is rich in Natural resources. Countries biggest supply of gas is by Balochistan. But the well paid managers and technicians are hired from other provinces in domestic gas industry. Local Balachs are hired as labours. Little amount of earning by government is paid back to province as development projects.

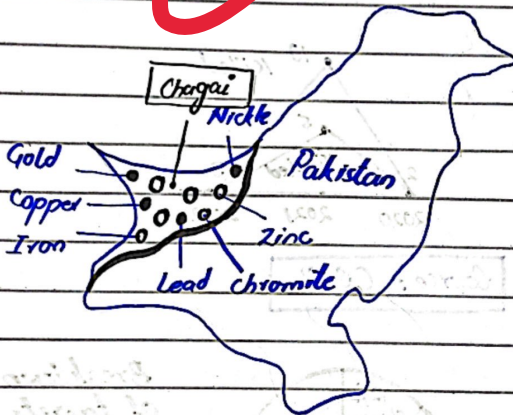


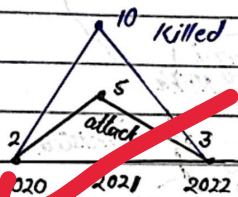
Fig: Resources in Balochistan

(1) Gawadar sea port; one of major causes of separatist movement as its development has not benefited province

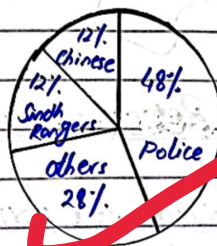
Gwadar port has great **strategic** and **economic importance** in Pakistan.

Breakdown of targets for terror attacks in Karachi by Baloch militant groups (2005-2021)

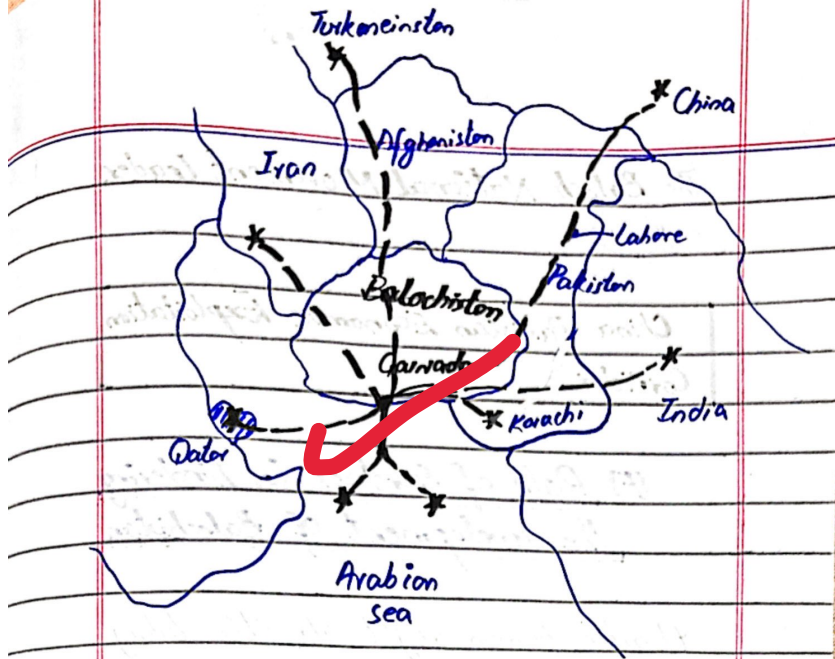


Fig: Strategic importance of Gwadar port

(E) CPEC and similar projects are seen as extractive by locals and have amplified Baloch animosity

CPEC has amplified anger among Baloch people. They see CPEC as sinister objective in Balochistan. They say that most of infrastructure used is Chinese and white collared jobs are gone to non-Baloch people.

(F) Role of Sardars in hindering the development of Balochistan

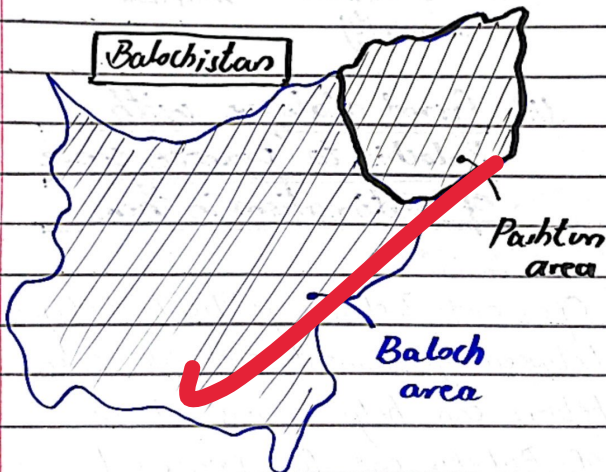
Horrible human right atrocities taking place in Balochistan have been defended by chieftains in name of cultural norms. It has censored the development of Balochistan, which has created sense of separatism in Baloch people.

(G) Demographic Engineering ; An effort by Pakistani Govt to convert majority into minority in Balochistan ; trigger to separatist movement

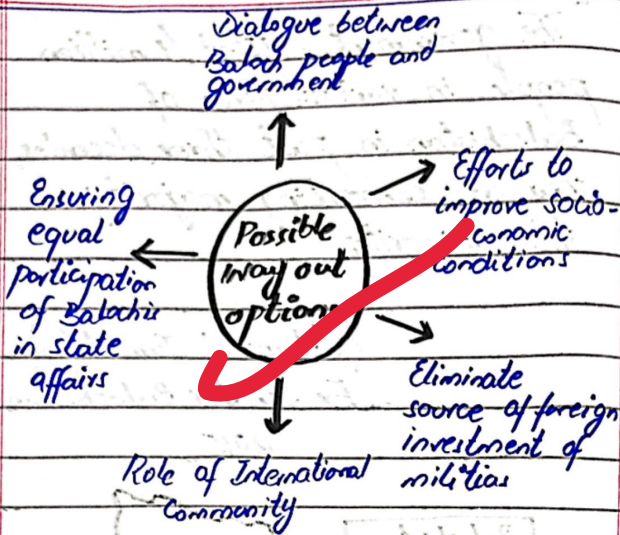
To counter Baloch insurgents the government of Pakistan started demographic engineering, to prove that Balochs are minority and Pashtuns are majority.

4) Possible wayouts for government of Pakistan to counter separatist sentiments



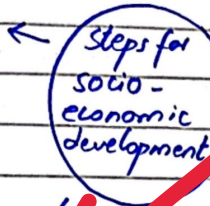
(A) Grand dialogue with Balochis to promote sense of Nationalism in them
