On the contrary, Sir Syed Ahmed Khan and his honourable, open-minded son Syed Mehmood tried to gain equal status to that of English. Not only Muslims but also Indians were oblivious of the Agra Court incident 1875. Sir Syed isolated himself from the English court citing the reason that Indians were conferred inferior seats to English. Sir Syed was to be awarded a medal from that court. Later, Commissioner of Meerath Kalimis was given charge to award that medal to Sir Syed at Ali Garh Railway Station.
