Discuss in detail the Plato's concept of justice?

Introduction:

Plato was born in Athens. He gained primary education in house. Later on, he moved to Socrates for higher education. He wrote three books which name are Republic, Statesman and Laws.

Context:

When Plato was studying. At that time, war occurred between Athens and Spartans. Athenians were democrates and Spartans are dictators. Spartans defeated Athens in war. Socrates was also a democrat. There was a direct democracy system. There are two reasons due to this, Plato stated an ideal state for people. His teacher Socrates ^{was} executed. Second is Peloponessian war. Plato opined justice is the foundation of ideal state.

Plato stated, there are three types in our society

Plato's concept of justice:

Plato explained that a man involved in three things, which are Lust, courage and wisdom. But one of them which is dominating human majority of the people involved in Lust. Some people are courageous and least people are wise. Plato explained that these three people divided into three different segments.

Lust	→	Artisan
Courage	→	Military
Wisdom	→	Rulers

So, majority of the people are artisans. Some people will join army and very few are rulers. So, when very few become rulers, that is not democratic system.


Ideal state:

Communism of Plato:

There are two types of communism:

1) Communism of property, The upper two classes do not allow any type of property. According to Plato, this is compulsory for upper two classes.

Communism of family,

They will not marry because they will not allow the private family. Plato says that a child is born with disability, he would be executed. Because he is useless for state.

Theory of Plato: State is the end and everything else is the means.

Criticism of Plato's concept:

The concept of justice by Plato has been exposed. There are different types of due to which Plato's concept criticizing on his theory.

Firstly, the concept of justice by Plato is mainly grounded on moral principles.

Second, Plato's theory of justice could be practical only in the city state system. It will not be impactful for other states.

Thirdly, he said that each individual owns three qualities like reason, spirit and appetite.

Fourth, his concept of justice gives absolute power to one class like the philosophers because they have a lot of wisdom. There is a scope of inequalities of power and in his concept of justice.

Fifthly, his justice gives rise to a class state. but the rest of all states are facing inequalities.

Critical analysis:

Plato gives a ideal state theory. He stated about the justice in the society. He approved a proper education policy. But at the end of his ideal state he gives the power in one hand. The rest of the segments deprived from the facilities of the society.
