2. Gender Equality is a Reality:

- i. Women can do everything a man can do let it be management of household chores or office work
 - *(Single mothers are its example along with spouses that earn to support their families financially)*
- ii. Women can't be ignored as they reside in all walks of life from millionaire list to leading nations at front
 - *(Giorgia Meloni, Italian PM)*
- iii. Women build nations and their economies by working side by side with males from labour level to top brass
 - *(Nordic and European countries' women and their involvement in state's affairs like Ursula von der Leyen, President of the European Commission)*
- iv. Organizations and Governments recognize women equally as man when it comes to jobs, considering their limitations as well
 - *(Providing paid-off during last months of pregnancy or provide day-care within office's premises)*
- v. The West progressed in past 150 years mainly through addressing women's concerns
 - *(from late 1880s women participation in politics to current wave of feminism to empower the role of women in a society)*
- vi. Women has proved themselves in military of a country as well
 - *(Ayesha Farooq, Squadron Leader of PAF, Nigar Johar, became the first woman to command in the history of the Pakistan Army)*

3. However, there exists a flip side of the coin that believes Gender Equality is a Myth (counter perspective):

- i. Islamic concept over equality of man and women that is man are virtual god for women
- ii. Women are not safe outside of homes as people may hurt her in unacceptable ways hence, she should not earn
- iii. Women are emotional and can not handle masses of people or commands in military

4. Despite these views, Gender Equality still remains a reality (Rebuttal):

- i. Islam does not stop a woman from doing anything but exclude her from many responsibilities and provide more rights to her than him
- ii. It is the mentality of the people that has rotten which label a women trying to be independent as indecent hence, deserve to be seen with loathe
- iii. Women are as strong as man emotionally as well as in combat strategies like in Hazrat Umer (RA) rule

5. Additionally, there are some suggestions to empower as well as implement Gender Equality in male-dominated societies for good:

- i. Transforming human psychology to accept women as equal through proper interpretation of religion and constitution followed by academic reforms, mass media and social drives
- ii. Regulating feminist movements so they do not divert from their goals and depicts itself as Misandrists movements
- iii. Delivering transparency in Women-abuse cases to encourage others too to raise their voices, meanwhile, curbing male unfearful nature of beast
