- a) Economic development

UNESCO report found that every \$1 spend on education, as much as \$10 to \$15 was generated in economic growth.

- b) Political stability

(NBER) study found that higher education level increased voter turnout and political awareness.

- c) Reduction in crime rate

Brookings institution proved that

10% increase in high school graduation rates leads to 9.4% reduction in arrest rates and 20% in crime rates.

Germany dual education system - helps in industry needs.

Global Innovation Index (GII) shows that countries with strong education system, particularly in STEM are innovation leaders.
