Denial to corruption along with de-centralization of local bodies, no political involvement, efficient judiciary system and above all the chief justice should not be entitled. all^{these parameters} collectively can ensure the accountability in our country Pakistan.

However some people do not believe it due to the fact (according to them) that elite class and politicians are above law. Justice is delayed or not even given in several cases as well as the military class being not accountable in country. There are several manifestations which show that elite class and politicians

are not above law, justice is served in many cases and military class is also accountable.

To begin with 'law above all'; The country needs to ensure the rule of law to be imposed on each and every person, ^{irrespective} of so-called class. as Aristotle says, "Law should govern and those who are in power should be servant of the laws." From a small shopkeeper to the higher class business man everyone is victimized, though no one can be accountable because every second person is culprit of other one. In addition to that, de-centralization of local bodies can also ensures it. The incorporation of local body into bureaucracy can be beneficial in good governance as evident during the presidency of General Pervez Musharraf 2001-2007. Similarly, the non-involvement of politicians can also ensure the accountability in our country. The political involvement can fragile the process of accountability as seen in several cases. The connections between elite class and politicians hinders the judiciary process. An example is 'Noor-Mugaddam case'. Her husband brutally killed her yet set free by the court due to his close relations with high political profiles. Thus to ensure the accountability the intercession of politicians, in such cases, needs to be rejected and not welcome. Along with that, the implementation of Islamic laws is need of the hour. The country needs to revise the punishments and set them as per Islam. The country is named after Islam and the supreme law is Almighty therefore the imposition of at least its punishments and trial process is

a must-do thing to ensure the accountability. There would not be a true accountability process until unless there is no implication of Islamic law.

Beside of that, the institutions needs should to be neutral. No any military influence or political influence ~~can~~ needs to be there on institutions. Country needs to reform the policies in this regard. For instance the civil servants should perform their duties neutrally. The democratic elected people are ~~people~~ there to serve the people with the help of "non-elected or non-democratic" civil bodies. However the state workers always fall as barrier and services are not delivered at time thus blaming each other. It also decline the possibility of accountability as no one ready to take responsibility of delayed service.

Beside that, The efficient judiciary is also a valid reason for accountability. Unfortunately, The judicial prosecutions take a long time to be done, in our country, therefore

people do not find the justice system as reliable as it should be. Indeed 'the justice delayed is justice denied.' The responsibilities are not taken to an account at time which slows the process of accountability. In fact there are so many cases in which the litigants passed away and court announced the decision after the demise of them. An efficient and fast-and steady judiciary system is needed to ensure the accountability.

Employment of chief justice for life time can also play an important role to keep them honest and truthful and provide the justice neutrally. In Pakistan, the justices and jurists of the Supreme court are set to retire at the age of 65, unless the jurists sooner resign or are removed. This can insure them and get them in a greed and lead them to corruption which in turn interrupt the process of accountability. The US judiciary system

is known as liable and the reason behind it- the supreme jurists are never get retired, thus. They are appointed for life time thus making them secure.

After giving the detailed arguments, it is now necessary important to know the opposite arguments as well.

Some people believe that elite class and politicians are above law. They can never face trials and subjected to punishments if they found guilty. They thought that they are exonerated of any charge shed and can never be accountable.

Similarly, some of them argue that justice is served always delayed in most of the cases therefore accountability is impossible to be achieved. They have lost their complete trust in responsible state holders and judiciary system. They can see the delayed justice only and give examples of

'Shahrukh Jatoi case': who is still
running around freely.

Moreover, people seem to
be rather pessimist with the attitude
of militant class. They argue that
the militant officer always imposed
martial law, whenever brought to the
government and not taken to an
account. Thus they can never be
accountable after doing a massive
politics.

After viewing the opposite side of thoughts,
it is now relevant to know the counter
points.

Firstly elite class and politicians
are not necessarily necessarily above the
law as can be evident in Tappu case.
The culprit was a judge wife yet
she had to face the charge
sheet of punishment of 1 year
imprisonment. This is ^{not} only the single
evidence. There are so many other
evidences are present too, however

this single example is more than enough to reject the ^{opposite} opinions.

Secondly, the statement that justice in our country is always delayed. It is not that true. As there are some important examples in which the culprit has got what he deserved. As evident in Rainab case; an ^{seven} eleven year old child, who got raped and killed brutally. ~~He~~ The culprit was hanged to death soon.

Lastly, the comment that military can never be accountable is totally a false statement. As can be evident in General Pervez Musharraf case.

The former leader of Pakistan was sentenced to death by special court. This is an example that no one is above law. Be it an elitarian, a politician or an army officer.

To conclude it, the accountability can be ensured in our beloved country Pakistan, if the rule of law, Islamic law, efficient judiciary system
