Socialism:

Socialism is a political and economic ideology that advocates for collective or governmental control over the means of production and distribution of goods to achieve social and economic equity. (10 marks)

Historical Background of Socialism:

Socialism emerged in the early 19th century as a reaction to the inequalities of industrial capitalism. Influential figures include Karl Marx and Friedrich Engels who articulated many of the key principles in words like "The Communist Manifesto" (1848).

(B) Marxist - Leninism :

Marxist - Leninism encompasses revolutionary socialism aimed at overthrowing capitalist systems and establishing a classless society.

"Soviet Union implemented Marxist - Leninist socialism with extensive state control over the economy and central planning."


(C) Utopian Socialism :
