01 Based on Motivation: (One time fraud)

In this category, Criminals are motivated for their vested interest. They have economical, political, Revenge, ideological and sexual interest.

At the cost of achievement they commit crimes.

Economic (Theft and Fraud).

These crimes are motivated financial will including, theft, fraud and moneylaundering.

Political (Terrorism)

Political crimes are motivated for vested interest. to achieve their goal, they cross the all limits and becomes the terrorist. and violation is always common phenomenon for them.

Revenge and Ideological motivation:

The In this category criminals are egoistic. when their ego gets hurt they commit heinous crime and take their revenge. This revenge and ideological motive always have target and honour killing. The last but not least sexual interest is also include in this. Some time sexual harassment and some time rape and killing.



## 2. Based on Organization:

In this category, criminals organize their crime places, victims, target, each and everything and then commit the crime. Sometimes they carry their mission successfully and sometimes not.

### 1. White Collar Crime:

White Collar Crimes are often successful missions which are committed very stealthily. Criminals deceived the others but they left no evidence behind it.

### 2. Blue collar Crime:

Blue collar crimes are more direct and include physical acts, such as burglary and assault.

## 3. Victim - Based on Victim:

In this type of crime, criminals are involved in physical activities and have the victim to hurt including, violation (murder), will of property, victimless (drugs & suicide), pro state.

## 4. Based on psychology:

The crimes which are based on psychological condition, the criminals often have medical disorders and which can be medically treated. In this category, criminals hurt their self and others and they shift the blame on others for their behaviour. In this types of crimes mostly, spouse murder, status achieving goals in a society,



Family depression and the other matters are included which are responsible for the crime.

## 4/ Based on Legal Severity:

There are rules and regulations in every society or a state. And everyone is abide by the law. When A person does not follow the rules then he/she legally commits the crime. In this category, there are two specific types for this criminal behaviours are as follow.

### 1/ Misdemeanors

Misdemeanors are legal crimes are punishable but these crimes are only limited to the fine and for short time jail ~~prison~~ imprisonment such as - fishing without license. etc.

### 2/ Felonies:

Felonies are the heinous crime and are always punishable by the law. In this type of crimes punishment is strict ~~and~~ including life-time jail or sentence of death.

## 5/ Based on Frequency:

The frequency based crime are habitual crimes. The criminal is become addicted to the commit the crime and achieve their goal. This crime include the (drugs, theft and sexual harassment etc.
