Pakistan should update its education syllabus. Pakistan should update curriculum and include modern syllabus in it.

Pakistan needs to revise syllabus every year in order to improve its education system. The Pakistan Education statistics 2022 report highlighted that a significant number of universities in Pakistan

have not updated their programmes to meet instrumental standards and industry needs.

In institution subject experts should be hired. Those who can help students in excelling in the field of their interests. Subject experts can help students in research and analytical domains. This is one of the most important step towards better education that can be beneficial in the prosperity of the country.

In Pakistan's educational institutes teacher training programme should be promoted.

O'Neill (1986) explained training as a person's systematic development of the information, attitudes and skills required for him to be able to perform adequately in a job and assignment, whose specification can be relatively well defined in advance and which demands a fairly standardized output from whoever attempts it.

Improving infrastructure is the need of the institutions because poor

infrastructure such as absence of advance laboratories, libraries and efficient building is the main obstacle in the promotion of education. Universities, colleges and schools should be built according to the modern needs of the students. Public schools in Pakistan do not have proper classrooms the basic furniture for example chairs are not available for the students. Students have to sit on the floor and the poor hygiene has resulted in increased number of health issues such as hepatitis, dengue, malaria, typhoid and diarrhea.

Government should provide students with scholarships and loans to get adequate education. Government should provide free education to the students who come from lower middle class background. Students should be given discount travel cards in order to reduce the expenses of travels.

Recently Punjab government has allocated

only Rs. 5.23bn budget to the universities for the FY 2023-2024. while the sindh government allocated Rs 10 bn budget to the universities.

- online education is also a good measure in order to combat expenses related to transport. This will not only help the students but also reduce the expenses of the teachers. A proper check and balance ^{system} should be introduced in the educational institutes. Everyone must be aware of his duties and must be afraid of accountability.

- Gender equality is crucial to make any country prosper and successful. Women empowerment is the need of the hour for any country like Pakistan. In Pakistani society patriarchy and misogynistic mindset has caged the women within the four walls. In rural areas women are not allowed to get education. Women education is necessary to make any country economically prosper. The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the United Nations include a specific

Proper health facilities should be given to women so that they can effectively participate in economy. Health facilities can improve the life expectancy of the women as well.

Such attitude of male political leaders should be reprimanded and prohibited in order to increase women participation in politics and society. Such derogatory remarks display bad image of the country to the outer world that is a significant obstacle to the prosperity of Pakistan.

Government should take steps to ensure legal and constitutional rights of women. Cases of women Abuse, violence and honour killing have been surging in Pakistan. In order to make Pakistan a prosper country equal opportunities and given rights of women must be ensured by
