When Quard-e-Azam took the leadership of Muslim league, he found them demoralized and people 9 without a proper leadership. He worked 1 hard to protect the rights of the Muslim minority and that struggle 24 resulted in a separate and an independant nation for the muslims, named Paleistan, a land of Pure.
