

An essay is primarily an organization of impressions. It carries the essence of the writer's experiences. The essayist does not take us into the details of the processes of thought which led him to the specific conclusions that constitute the essay. He gives us the fruits of his labour, not the complexities of his cogitations. He offers not the detail of psychological process but the finished articles: the social and psychological products. Also, he does not try to communicate his conclusions through established artistic or intellectual devices. He addresses the reader directly, bringing home to him in the most concise and pithy form the results of his investigations without going into the labyrinth of logic. Thus Bacon's writing *Of Truth* neither indulges in philosophy nor dilates upon the difficulties encountered in the pursuit of truth, though he does allude to various philosophies and points to certain difficulties. An essay is different from novel, a short story or a play in that whereas all these forms of literature attempt at the communication of the experience. The novelist and the dramatist portray the experience and leave it to the reader or the spectator to draw his own conclusion. If they try to give their own conclusion, they will sound didactic, and art will deteriorate into sermon. In other words, an essay tries to communicate those impressions which are artistically incommunicable through any other form of literature. It does not give only 'picture' of life, but comment on it and raises this comment to the level of art. This comment is always direct, though sometimes embellished with metaphors and allusions. Such a comment is always implicit in any literary work, but it is never overt. In an essay, it is clear, direct and deliberate.ⁱⁱ

He does not communicate his point through established conclusions. He addresses the reader directly and provides the result in a concise form without letting them ~~to~~ go in detail and logic. On the other hand, essay communicates those impressions which are not communicate through any other form of literature. It not only provide the picture of life but also comment on it. This comment is always direct and implicit. In essay, it is clear, direct and deliberate.
