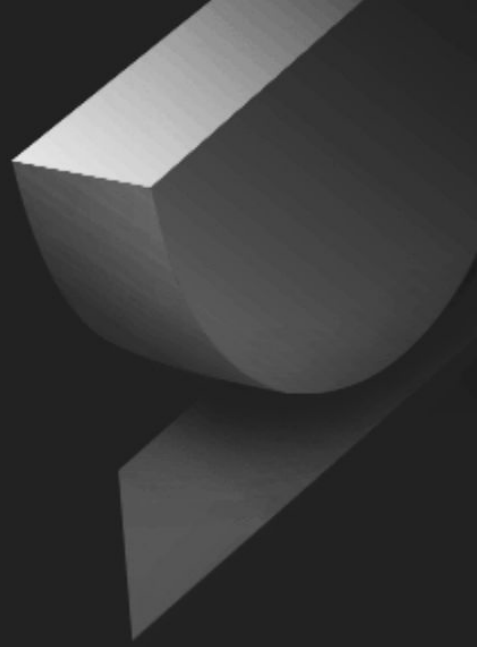

2. The terror of Israel on Gaza:

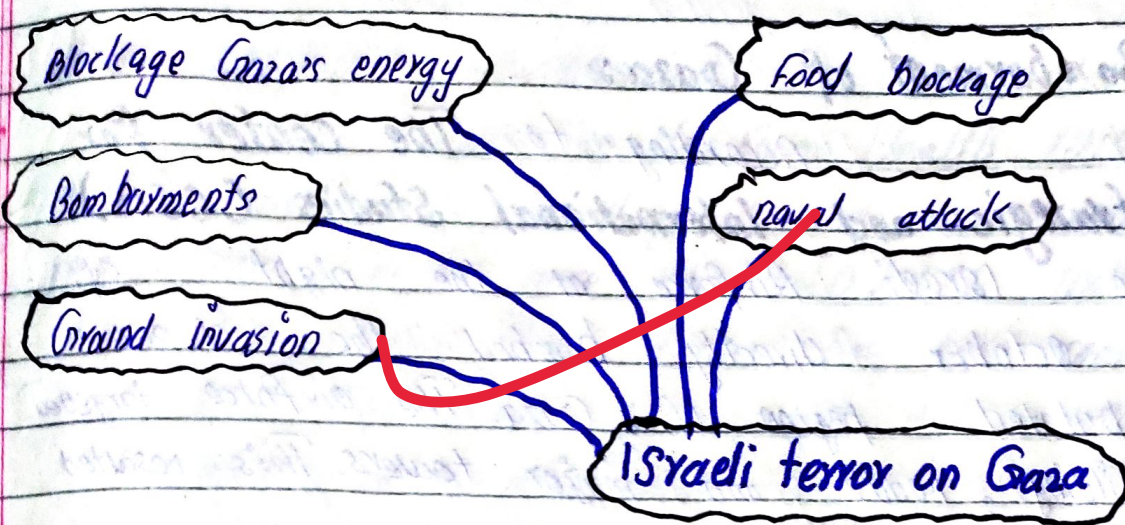


Figure 0.1 flow chart of Israeli terror

1. Blockage of Gaza's energy:

On the 7 October night, the spoke person of Israeli Defence force (IDF) **Deanial Hagri** announced the complete shut down of energy to Gaza. The energy included oil, gas and electronicity which have been flowing from the Israeli borders. This terror pushed the civilians into hot water conditions.

2. Food blockage against Gazans:

The Defence minister **Yua Gallant** also order the (IDF) to block water and food items flowing to Gaza. This a clear terror on the 2.5 million population of

Gaza. That is also considered a war crime.

3. Bombardment of Gaza:

According to The Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS), the Israeli Airforce at the night of 8 October directly bombed the dense populated region of Gaza. The airforce targeted buildings, roads and major towers. This resulted mass casualties.

4. Naval invasion on Gaza:

The Israeli Navy also targeted the Gaza from seas. According to Wafa News, thousands of projectiles hit the heart of Gaza. Consequently, number of people died. The terror spread till the ground invasion.

5. Ground invasion of Gaza:

According to U.S State Departement, the ground invasion included German, US and French made tanks, armed cars and air force. The tanks reached to every corner of the Gaza. Consequently, the Gazans faced horrible conditions.

3. Israel's Gaza terror as a classical example of war crimes:

1. Mass casualties as a classical instance of war crime:

According to Gaza Health ministry, 41468 individuals including children and women have been killed, more than 102666 individuals have been injured. This figure has been confirmed by UN too. After the WWII, this number is massive number of deaths in the history. Thus, killing such huge number of people is the instance of war crimes.

2. Targetting Civilian infrastructure as a example of war crimes:

According to Al-jazeera Report 2024, schools, refugee camps like Jabulia Refugee Camp, hospitals like Al-Shafa Hospital Gaza and masjids have been directly targetted by the Israelis. According to International law targetting schools, hospitals and worship places are directly war crimes. Thus, Israel has been made accountable as committing Genocide in Gaza.

3. Targetting aid groups:

2. Chances of Continuation and expansion of Hamas-Israel war:

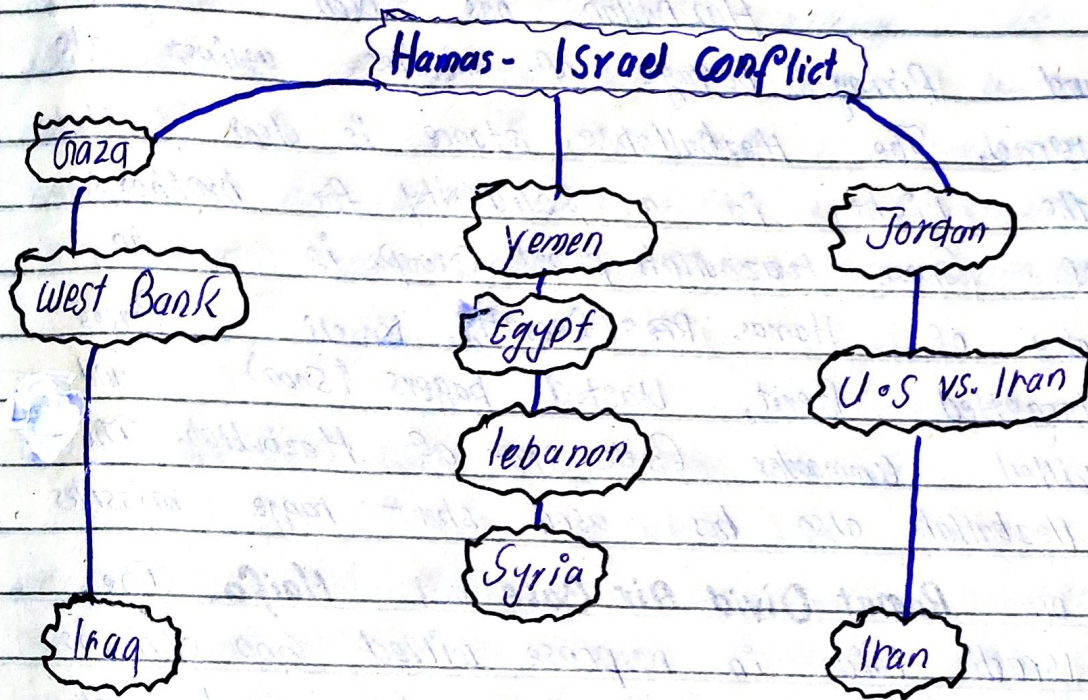


Figure 0.2 Chart of expansion of Hamas-Israel war
